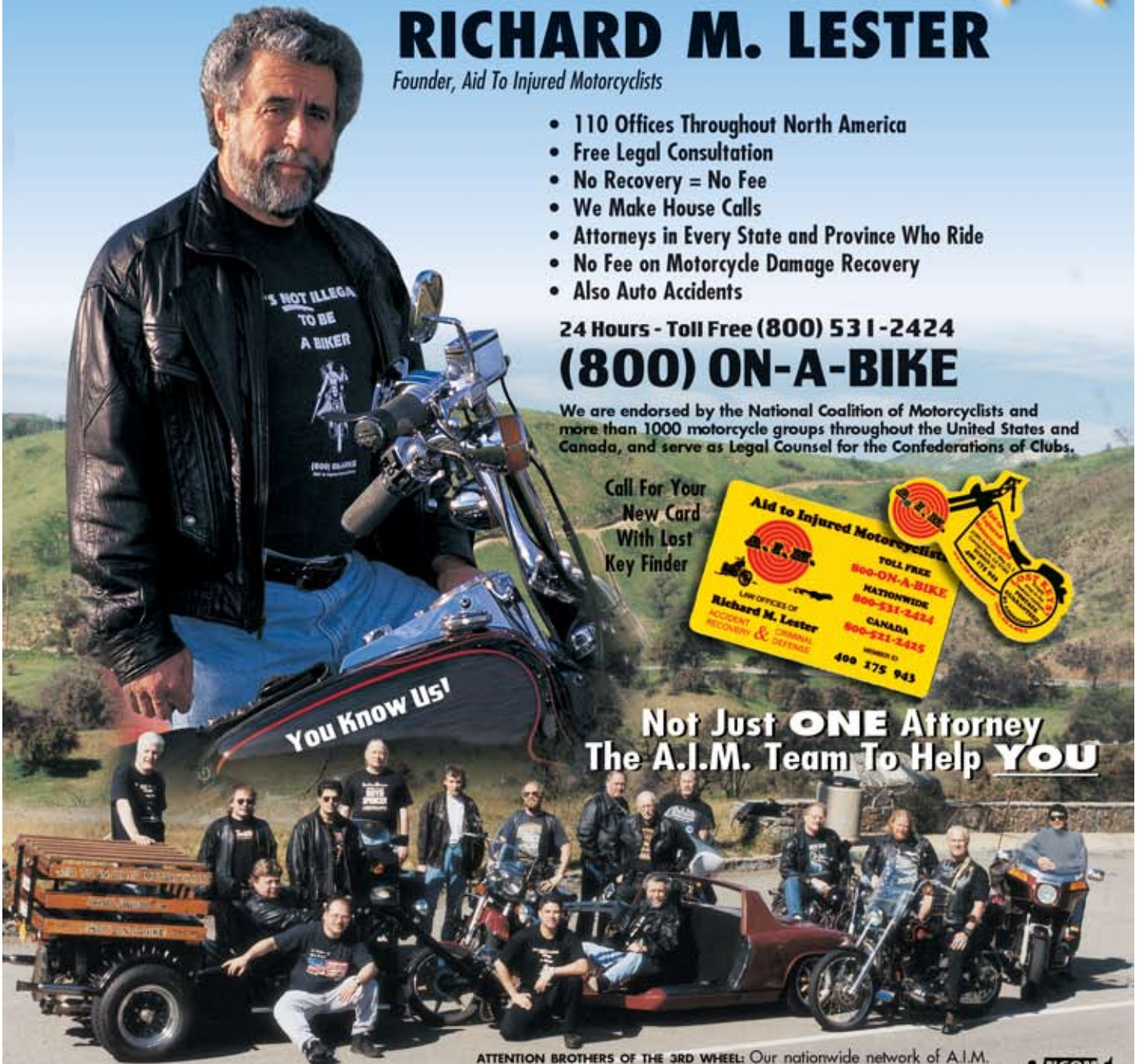

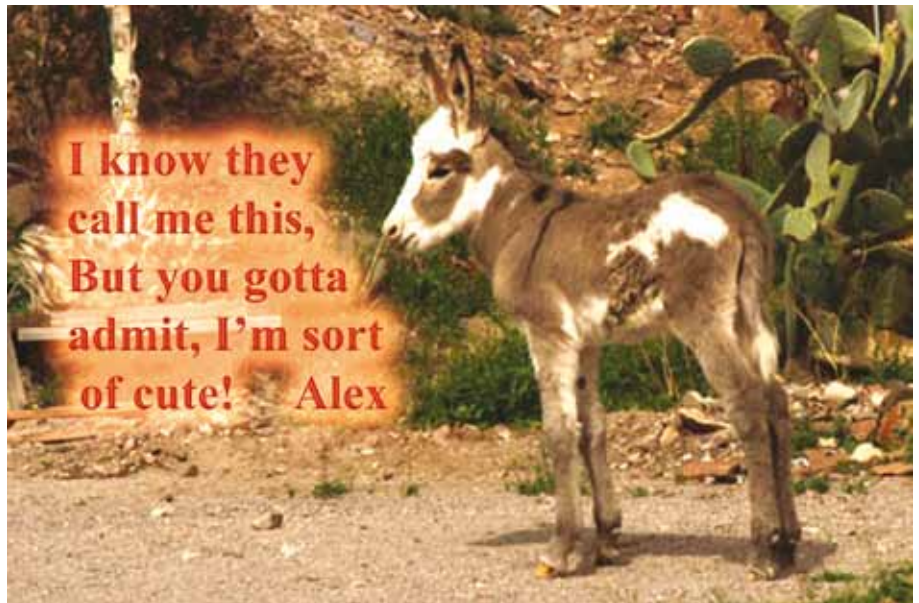
FROM YOUR BTW HEADQUARTERS

BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION SCHEDULE

BTW is split into 10 Regions; 9 of these regions are in the USA and Canada and the final one covers all areas outside of the USA & Canada. Each Region has a Regional Director. The Regional Directors serve as the Board of Directors. The Board makes decisions regarding the running of BTW. Each Regional Director is elected for a three-year term by the Directors in their Regions. If your Regional Director is not participating in the Board Meetings or being in touch with the State/Chapter Directors in their region, it is up to the membership to request them to step down. The Regions are set out on the Contact page 2. For more information, contact Headquarters.

Election schedule is as follows:

2013: Regions 2 (completed), 5 (completed), 8 (pending) **2014:** Regions 3, 6, 9 **2015:** Regions 1, 4, 7, and 10

BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTIONS 2013

If you are a member living in Regions **2, 5 or 8** here is something to think about. **Your representative on the BOD is up for re-election during 2013.** If you want more info about being a member of the BTW Board of Directors and what it entails, contact your current BOD and ask them what they do.

We, Shaun & Jackie, Region 10 Directors, are the people given the responsibility for finding your representative for the next 3 years.

The information is offered to help existing and those considering taking on this responsibility as a director.

CHAPTER DIRECTORS: A chapter director is required to provide the following services for his members:

- A. Coordinate the promotion of BTW to increase the membership in that chapter.
- B. Coordinate chapter activities, events and meetings
- C. Receive all requests for assistance and provide assistance with BTW issues from ALL the chapter members
- D. Provide and/or disperse all required information & materials to and from BTW and ALL the chapter members
- E. Act as a liaison and representative of BTW, making sure All members in that Chapter are properly represented and that they conduct themselves in accordance with the bi laws of BTW, Inc.
- F. Create and maintain an open communication link with their membership to ensure the flow of information and materials

STATE DIRECTORS : A State Director is required to provide the following services for his/her State:

- A. Coordinate the promotion of BTW to increase the membership in that State
- B. Receive all requests for assistance and provide assistance with BTW issues from ALL the chapter members
- C. Provide and/or disperse all required information & materials to and from BTW, Chapter Directors and ALL the members in their State
- D. Act as a liaison and representative of BTW, making sure All members in that State are properly represented and that they conduct themselves in accordance with the bi laws of BTW, Inc.
- G. Create and maintain an open communication link with their membership to ensure the flow of information and materials.

REGIONAL DIRECTORS: A Regional Director is required to provide the following services:

- A. Coordinate the promotion of BTW to increase the membership in that Region.
- B. Receive all requests for assistance and provide assistance with BTW issues from ALL director or member in that region.
- C. Provide and/or disperse all required information & materials to and from BTW, State & Chapter Directors, and ALL the members in that region.
- D. Act as a liaison and representative of BTW, making sure All members in that Region are properly represented and that they conduct themselves in accordance with the bi laws of BTW, Inc.
- E. Create and maintain an open communication link with their membership to ensure the flow of information and materials

BOARD OF DIRECTORS: A Board Member is required to provide the following services:

- A. Receive all requests for assistance and provide assistance with BTW issues from ALL directors or members of BTW.
- B. Coordinate the promotion of BTW to increase the membership.
- C. Act as a liaison and representative of BTW, making sure All members are properly represented and that they conduct themselves in accordance with the bi laws of BTW, Inc.
- D. Provide any BOD.
- E. Provide input to the board, based on the best interest of the membership, as a whole, regarding any issues pertaining to the required operations and furthering of BTW.
- F. Audit the activities of the Executive committee on a scheduled basis.
- G. Requires assistance to the Executive committee and Headquarters to improve and promote BTW as a whole.
- H. Maintain a constant communication with the entire membership of their Region through the Directors



ARTICLES FROM THE MEMBERS

Anna Sullentrup is my granddaughter. Below is a story she wrote for her school class, as we all know your life can change in a instant, and it has for me.

A Life Changing Experience

My Grandpa is a triker. Like a motorcyclist only with 3 wheels. He was the type of Grandpa who loves to build everything. Because he was that kind of person, he built his own trike. It was painted a sparkles purple and had red and yellow flames on the sides that intertwined so perfectly it really did look like fire. When he started it up, the engine roared like a lion just right that when I was younger



it was probably the coolest thing I have heard come out of a vehicle. His trike had a front seat and a back seat. Both were covered in black leather that got hot in the summer when my brother and I came over to his house to take rides on the trike. The summer I was turning 16, everything changed. I remember what his trike looked like after the accident he and his friend got into. I looked at the piece of scrap metal. It looked like something from the junk yard that someone would carelessly throwaway.

Just last year, it felt like everything was okay. It felt like everything was actually normal. I remember it so vividly that it still sometimes makes me shiver. It was one week before my birthday. My friends and I had big plans to go horseback riding that weekend. Although those plans were soon ruined.

Grandpa, her Dad, was in a motorcycle accident. I asked what had exactly happened. As she started to explain the accident, I became more and more worried that he was not OK. She told me that my Grandpa was driving his trike and another car was turning in the wrong lane or try to avoid but if it failed, he knew he would be hit. He had to make a quick decision. So he did the unthinkable and made the decision to avoid and he was hit. She told me that he was hurt very bad and if he was not wearing his helmet he would have died. Although my Grandpa made it, his friend that was sitting in the back of his trike did not make it. He died instantly.

I was coming off the bus from school and my Mom was at home. It felt like a regular day. When I got home my Mom gave me news that my

Even though my Grandpa was strong during this tragedy. There is a tremendous down side to the story. As my Grandpa was in the hospital, his leg that in the accident was the most injured, became very infected. The doctors at the hospital told us that he would have to have his leg amputated. He agreed to do the operation. He knew that his freedom would be taken away and he still agreed. After his leg was amputated, I thought he would be very different but when I came to see him for the first time after the surgery, I still saw the happy, cheery and amazing Grandpa I knew before the accident even happened. I was proud of him.

The stress was killing our whole family. My Mom and Grandma came to visit him every day. His spirits were high and so was his confidence. We all knew that he was going to make it. My Mom and Grandma were very worried that my Grandpa was not going to be able to move back into his house. And even if he was able to, they had to make adjustments to his house. Even though my Grandpa is stubborn, he knew it would take time to recover and finally get home.

My Grandpa is now in a nursing home recovering. I am very proud of him for being so strong and setting a great example for my family that even though a life changing experience can change everything in an instant, you must make the best of a bad situation. That is exactly what my grandpa did.
