A few of our members went to the Central States Trike-in, in Kentucky and had a great time riding

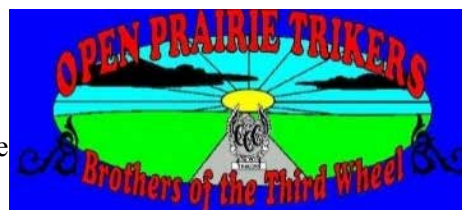
and visiting with friends from all over. Gary Harris even entered his trike in the show and won a trophy. Looking forward to next year's event.

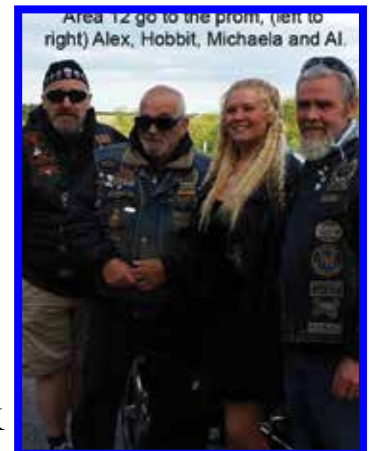
