To ride a real Chopper you have got to be in shape, a die hard biker and a complete idiot. I sure was all those things when I rode them. I truly believe nothing looks better than a Harley-Davidson that has been turned into a righteous chopper. Whether it is a Flat Head, Knuckle, Pan or Shovel and even the newer engines, they all look as if they are going 60 mph sitting still. Each builder puts his or her individuality into their bike with custom paint, wheels, frames, engine work and upholstery.

When I first started Chopping bikes the Harley's were very primitive, hand shifts and foot clutches. Old style Springer front ends were cut in half and then extended with tubes or newer forks installed with extensions to increase ground clearance and stretch the front end. The handlebars were changed to Ape Hangers, Z Bars, High Rise or Pull Backs with Sissy Bars attached at the same angle. Engines were bored and stroked with heavy duty valve springs and lighter weight cams and rods. Then, of course the loudest exhausts pipes were attached. The 5 gallon gas tanks were replaced with small bobbed tanks or sporty single type tanks. The seats were small and usually used for solo riding. Some builders even molded the frames for a real special effect. Front brakes & fenders were eliminated along with electric horns and double mirrors. Rear fenders were cut, bobbed and painted, everything else was chromed. They were not the safest bikes, but they looked cool and got lots of attention.

I never paid much for my bikes, they had blown engines, sat for years in barns and sheds or were insurance wrecks. I owned and built over 50 Choppers, but they are much different now. All cycle brands developed lines of Choppers that can be purchase off the showroom floor. Other companies manufacture Choppers that are superior to Harley-Davidson and cost a lot more. S & S, Texas Choppers, OCC, West Coast and Big Dog Choppers are just a few that market these products. There are many Chopper shows and weekly series on TV that are viewed by millions. Choppers are big business in America, an enigma that fascinates many, no matter what age, gender, ethnicity or position in society.

My Chopper riding was more extensive than those riding now. I straddled my Chopper, threw a change of clothes in a sleeping bag, strapped it to the sissy bar and took off. I rode many miles on Choppers but was much younger, healthier and stupid. I hit the show circuit for a few years and won a lot of trophies with my bikes. Most Chopper riders now, trailer their bike to the destination then ride. Others just ride them across town and back or take Sunday afternoon rides to show them off. They are expensive toys and luxury items that I can't afford or even want.

When I first started Chopping bikes I knew nothing about Harley's, with the help of two old Harley Dealers that lived in town and another old TT racer, I soon learned a lot more than most individuals want to know. I could strip a bike down within a couple hours using air tools. I could even take a Harley engine out of the frame in 28 minutes. I could do a complete top end job in 2.5 hours including sand blasting and painting the heads. When a local man opened his Harley Dealership near Columbus, he asked me to be his mechanic and sent me to Harley-Davidson mechanic's school to learn more about the bikes. I really enjoyed those days but soon realized that working on motorcycles all the time left me less interested in riding. I needed a break from being a mechanic, on any bike.

It really doesn't matter what anyone rides, it's the same wind in your face. I now ride a VW Trike, because I enjoy getting there in comfort, style and returning safely. Geno BTW #4051383

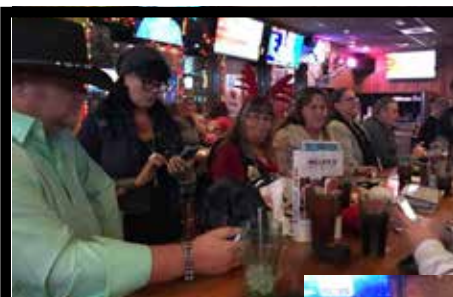

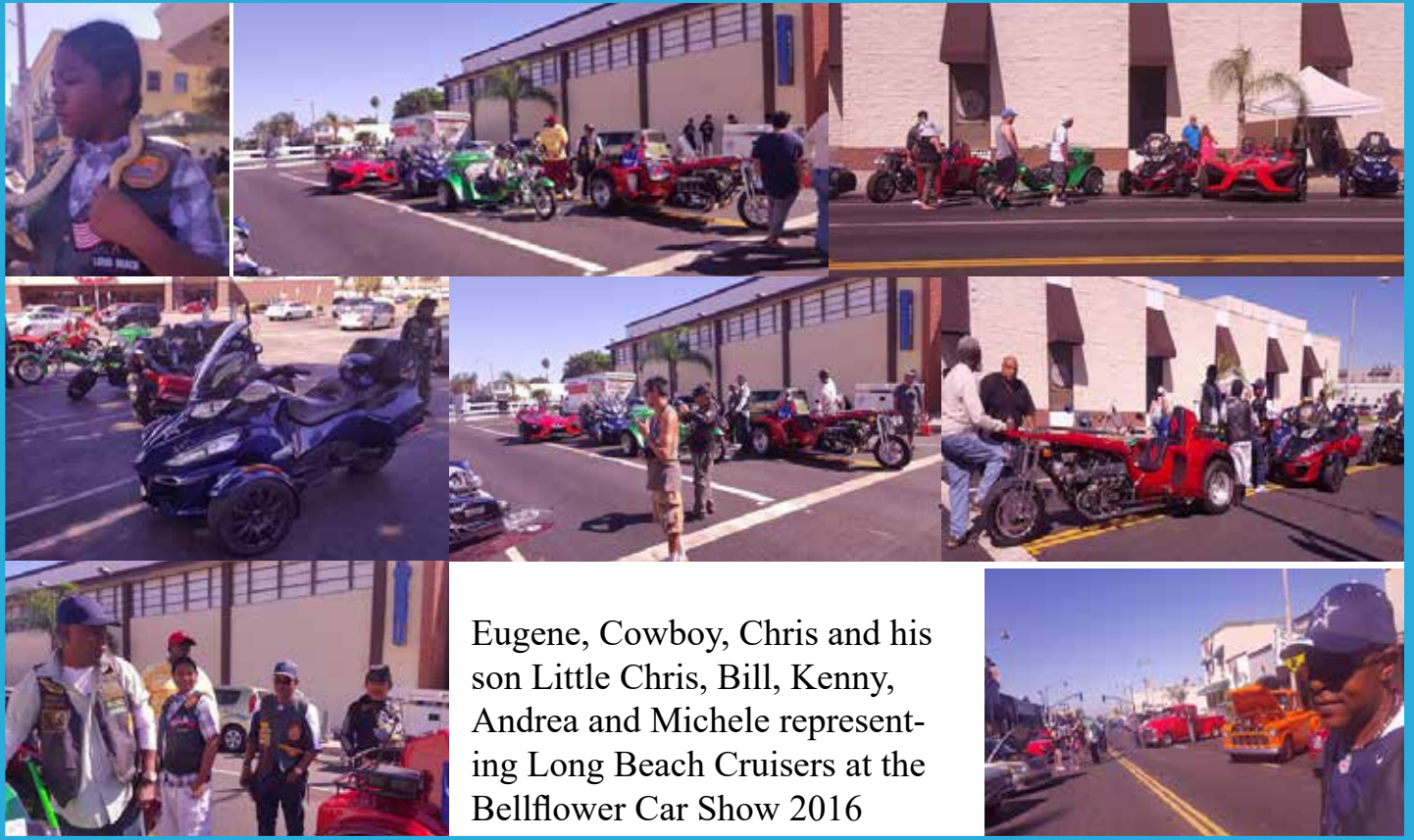

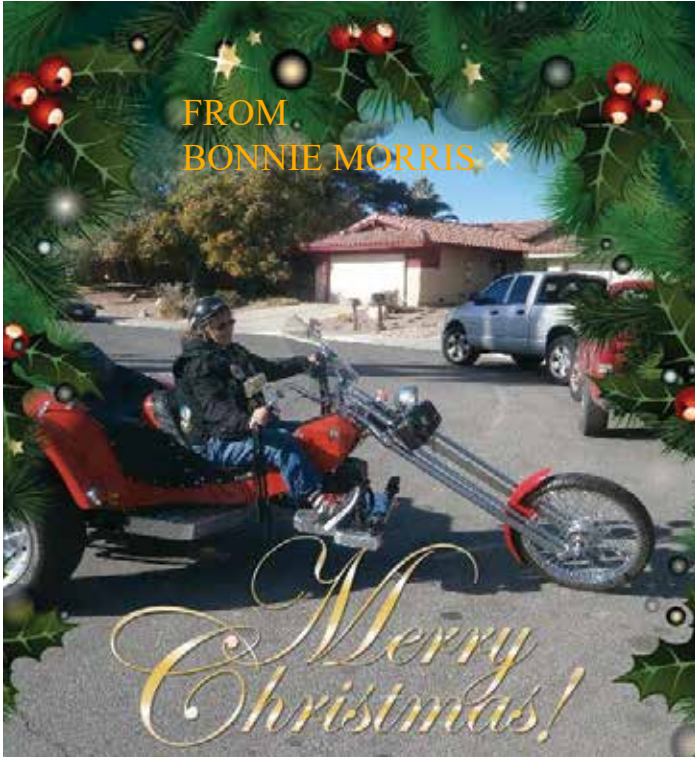
