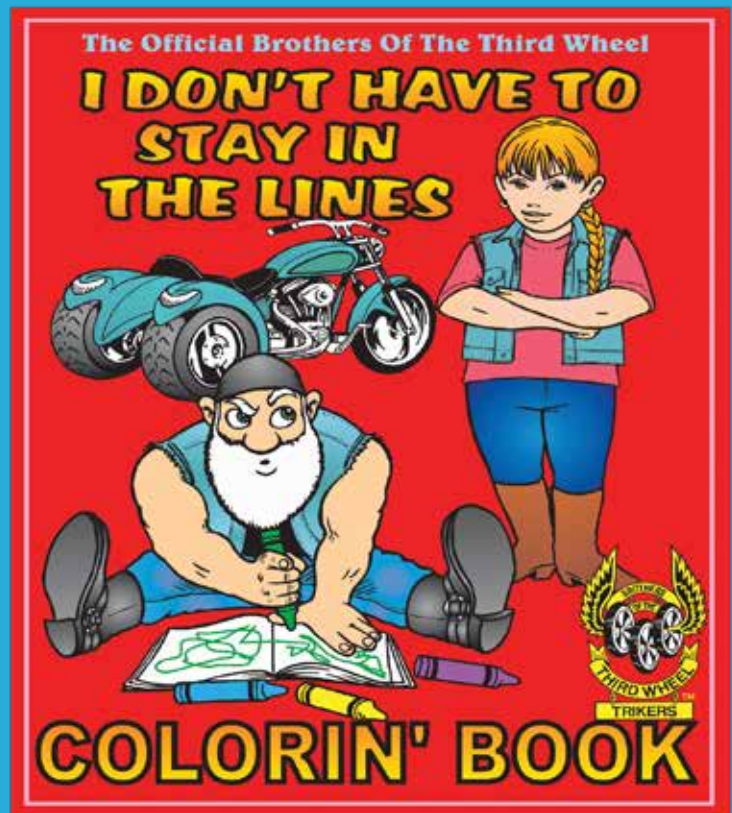

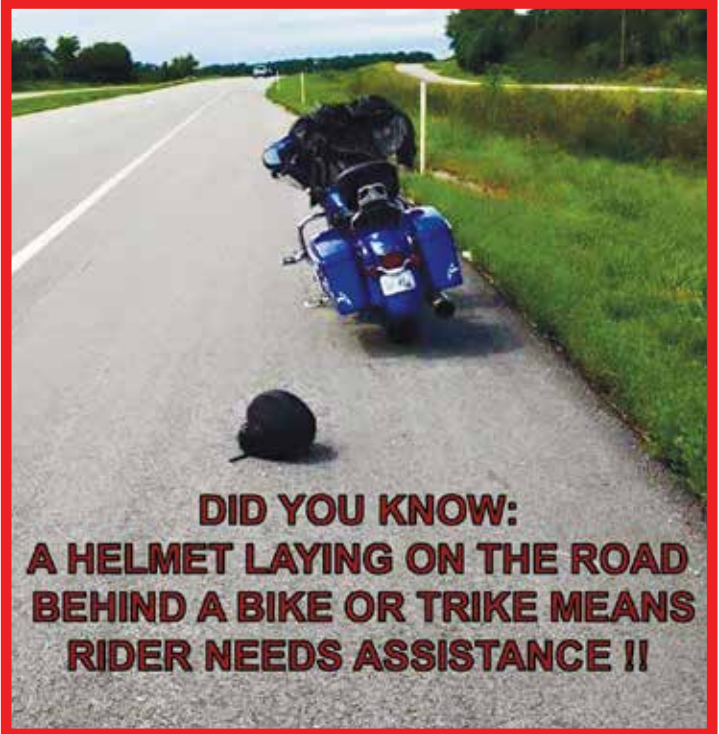

BTW BOD Elections

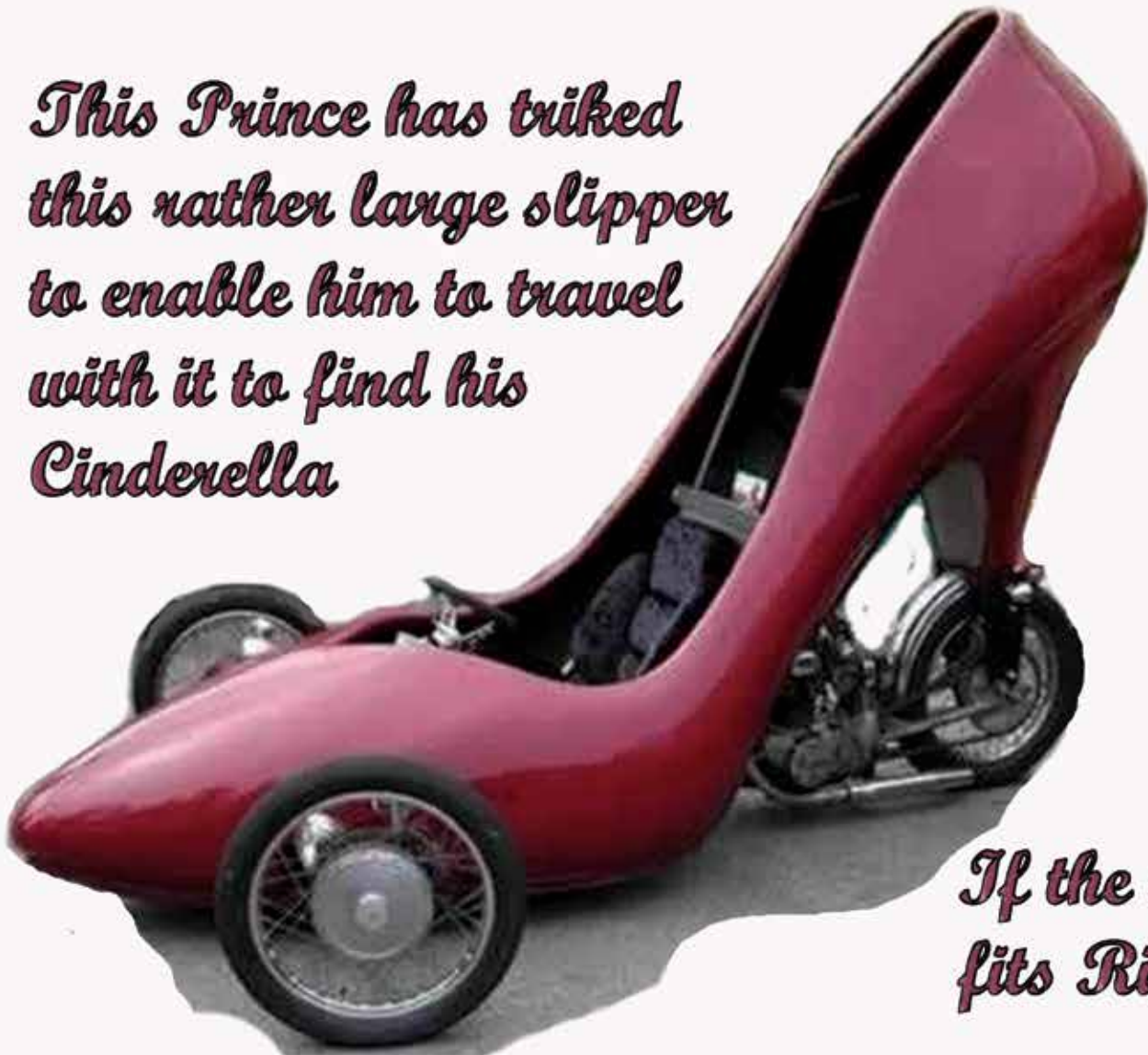
