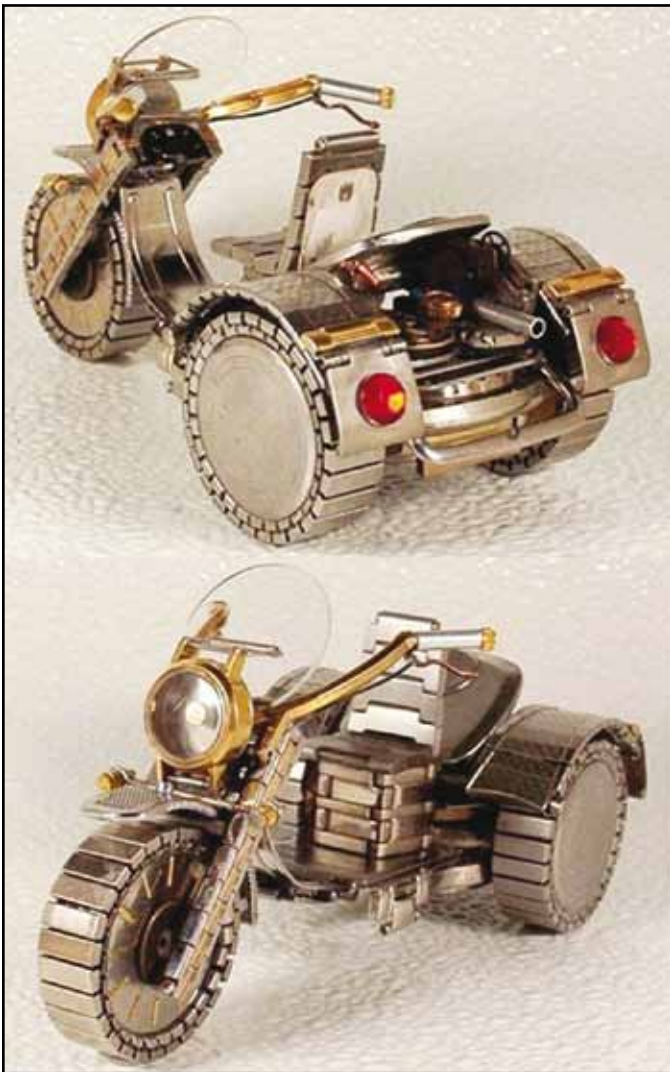

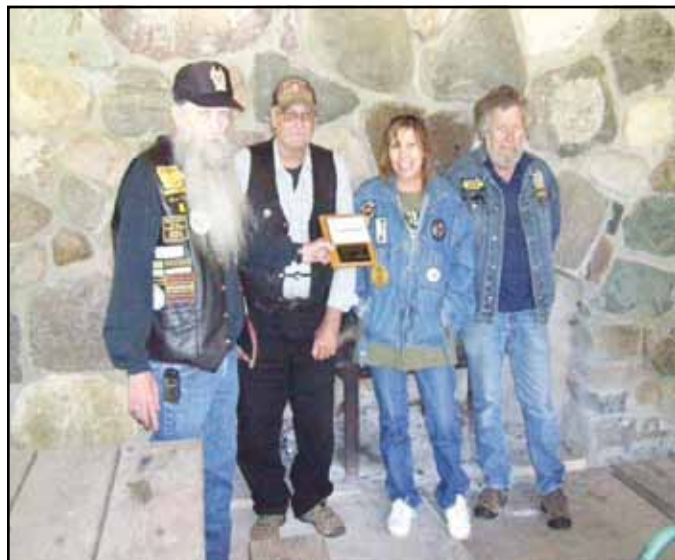

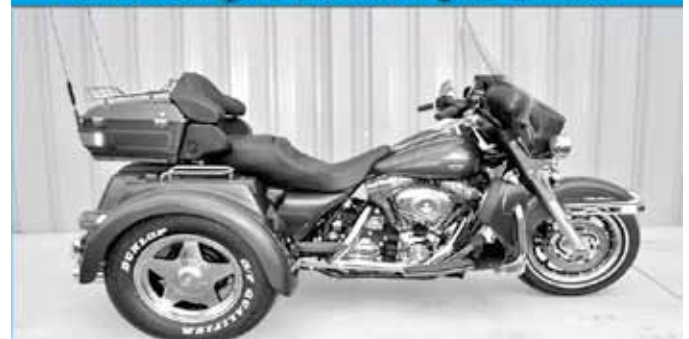

WD-40 USES:

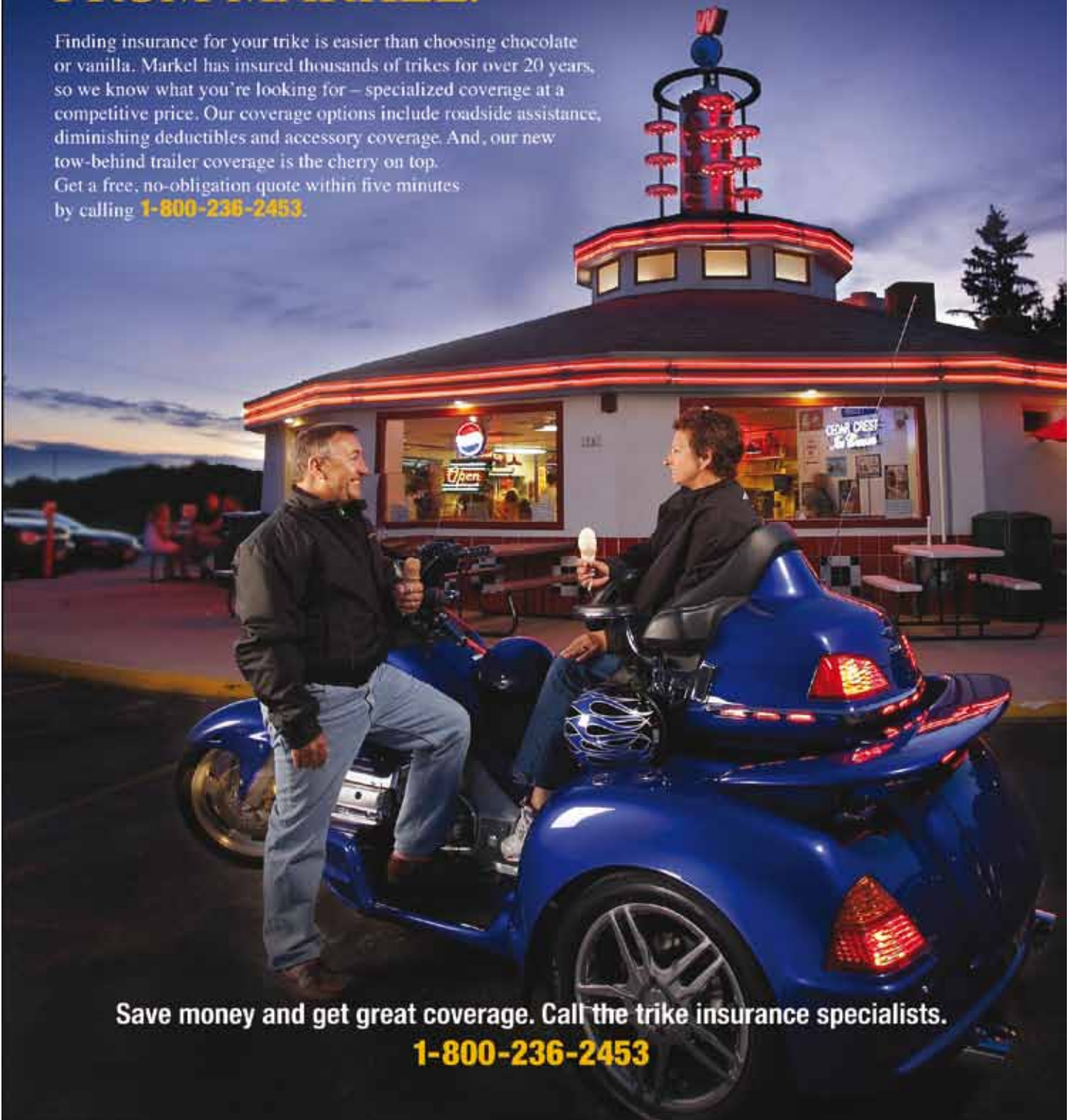
1. Protects silver from tarnishing.

When he got to me he stopped, smiled, held out his hand, and said, I want to shake your hand. I stood and took the Captain's hand. With a booming voice he said, 'I was a soldier and I was a military pilot. Once, someone bought me a lunch. It was an act of kindness I never forgot. I was embarrassed when applause was heard from the passengers. Later I walked to the front to stretch my legs. A man seated 6 rows in front of me reached out his hand, wanting to shake mine. He left another \$25 in my palm. When we landed I gathered my belongings and started to deplane. Waiting inside the airplane door was a man who stopped me, put something in my shirt pocket, turned, and walked away without saying a word. Another \$25! Upon entering the terminal, I saw the soldiers gathering for their trip to the base. I walked over and handed them \$75. 'It will take you some time to reach the base. It will be about time for a sandwich. God Bless You.' 10 young men left feeling the love and respect of their fellow travelers. Walking to my car, I whispered a prayer for their safe return. These soldiers were giving their all for us. I could only give them a couple of meals. It seemed so little. A veteran is someone who, at one point in his life wrote a blank check made payable to 'The USA' for an amount up to and including my life. **That is Honor**, and there are too many people in this country who no longer understand it.
