“Helmets”

“Helmet Laws Suck” That’s just one of the many bumper stickers I’ve seen in protest of wearing motorcycle safety helmets. I’m not writing this story to bore you with never ending statistics or dry facts about how wearing a helmet will greatly improve the chance of saving your life or serious injury should an accident occur while riding your trike. The first few months of 2010 “Wing World” magazine addressed those issues in full. I believe everyone over the age of 12 should know and recognize that as a fact, however, I also think everyone realizes that hitting a semi or tree head on, going 60 mph will surely lead to ones demise, helmet or no helmet. I’m just going to share my own feelings about wearing helmets and the laws.

This topic seems to be as controversial as Abortion or legalizing Marijuana. I have logged over 350,000 miles in my 53 years of riding motorcycles and I have sustained multiple injuries and brushes with death. I knew when I started riding that it was defensive driving that had to be learned and I needed all the skills, knowledge and body protection I could get to survive. Today, everyone needs that same formula, perhaps even more. All motorcycle manufactures recommend wearing helmets and eye protection, most advise the rider to wear long sleeve shirts, pants, gloves and over the ankle boots. If anyone disbelieves these options work, they are only fooling themselves. 21 States require helmets. I have endured accidents caused by other motorists running stop lights and stop signs, backing out in front of me, passing other vehicles as I am oncoming and the all time favorite, crossing over the center line on curves and hills. I’ve never kept track of how many times I avoided accidents by being alert with quick reactions and good defensive driving skills. No matter what you wear on your body for protection, nothing can beat skill levels in avoiding accidents, and I mean nothing.

Many times I’ve taken my ride to the ditch or laid it down on the road to avoid hitting unaware motorists doing stupid stuff. Yes, helmets helped me survive. But each close encounter was better served by my knowledge and awareness of fore thought. I hate wearing helmets, I’ve had Bell, Shoei, Arai and every other brand and they all suck. They never fit me well and they all have wind noise and hurt my head. Everyone I ride with wears helmets religiously and all Chapter riders would never go without them. Most of the time I wear a helmet, but when I don’t I feel I’m being judged unsafe, dumb, and reckless.

When I first started riding most riders didn’t have helmets or even know where to purchase one. At 16 my girlfriends parents requested me to “get her a helmet”. I bought one through the mail from J.C. Whitney. I admit that I did some stupid stuff during my motorcycle tenure. I have ridden old Harley’s thousands of miles with just a T-Shirt, torn jeans, tennis shoes, sunglasses and a bed roll. I remember riding through Texas rain storms that turned into snow flurries and ended in a heat wave that rode my clothes dry in one day. I’ve slept under picnic tables, in cemeteries, fairgrounds and old barns off the beat in path. Many times I’ve been lost, worried and confused. I went up down ramps and down up ramps just to get where I wanted to go. I’ve met some really great people and some truly bad boy undesirables. Through it all, helmets were never an issue.

I always wear long pants, shoes, shirt, gloves and eye wear when riding and so does my co-rider. I cringe when I see someone riding with shorts, a muscle shirt and flip flops. Most of those rider’s are an accident waiting to happen. In all my heart is the belief that beginners need training and courses in motorcycling. However, motorists also need training and refresher courses in awareness for other’s on the road. “Look Twice, Save A Life” is the perfect credo for motorists. The new motto from GWRRA is “Share The Road”, which needs to be adhered too. My biggest problem with any law, is that it is just that, a law. Helmet laws, seat belt laws, health care laws, they are all made to help us, Joe Q. Public. BULL! Laws cut into my rights. They force me to do something I may not want to do. Laws take away freedoms and tend to have negative impacts on We, The People. The real problem with all LAWS, they are not enforced on all equally. I have spent my whole life abiding by the law. I know if I break laws, I have to suffer consequences. Those can be harsh, from beatings at home from parents to death sentences in prison. I have always been afraid of such consequences. Some, don’t

care or understand those consequences so laws don't hold true to them, other's have never experienced any results of being held accountable for their actions. Those individuals feel they are above the laws and can avoid all consequences. The laws I believe in and try to live by are simple, they were taught to me at an early age and I have never forgot any of them. They are the "Ten Commandments", and more of us should live by those. The more man made laws, the more government and political rhetoric we must endure.

I never judge what anyone rides, drives, wears or does, unless it involves me. I could care less if someone must judge me as to what I ride, drive, wear or do, because it doesn't affect them. I believe in The Constitution and the freedom it affords us. I will continue to ride with and without a helmet. I will always take the heat from my riding friends when I don't wear one. I hope it never becomes a law in this great state. **Geno**

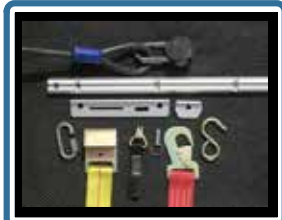

Trike-About: What is it???

The Open Prairie Trikers, a Kansas BTW chapter, back in 2010 set up a committee to dream up an annual ride that would be somewhat unique and hopefully an event that other chapters might consider doing as well, regardless as to the size of their chapter. The basic concept of this type of event is that no matter where each of us live, many of the things we take for granted, can be of great interest to others. Therefore, any chapter, large or small, or even just an individual BTW member could organize a Trike-About event! When dreaming up this event the chapter was low on funds but wanted to have an event so the planning began for an event where the chapter could be good hosts to fellow trikers not so familiar with the area and lead them to points of interest and things to do in the Chapter's area. Since this was a new type of adventure the group coined the phrase "Trike-About" to describe the event. This Trike-About event could be a one day event or an event that is extended through out a weekend or whatever. Regardless, good planning and being well organized, along with being very courteous hosts to your guests, is what makes any event a great success. This kind of event does not require a large outlay of cash, mostly some creative thinking and planning. Also keep in mind most trikers are in it "for the ride" so your event does not have to be the discovery of the Titanic! Just something that's interesting and enjoyable, something you'd have fun taking a friend to. There are no limits to the many possibilities in planning a Trike-About. For example, invitations to your Trike-About could be open to anyone or by special invitation only. However you do it, it is very helpful in having an idea of how many might plan to attend your event.

The Open Prairie Trikers first Trike-About event was scheduled a Friday evening, all day Saturday & Sunday morning. On Friday evening they planned a little meet and greet with sandwiches, chips and drinks. Chapter members brought condiments, salads and desserts and the chapter purchased the bread and meat. Those attending were given a detailed outline of all the events for the weekend with maps and instructions. No one had to go to all the planned events. They could pick and choose. The Motel we set up for our guests included a group discount and provided their breakfast room as a place for the meet and greet, at no additional charge. Some chapter members opened their homes to guests to also save some motel fees. Saturday morning we met at a Spangles Fast food and then triked to a small town about 18 miles that was having a parade. We joined them in their parade. Our group of trikes stretched out close to 1/2 mile long and more area trikers met us at the parade. Impressive indeed! That town was so grateful for the unique parade entry, they later sent our chapter a \$100 award for being the best organized group. (We all had a good laugh on that one!) The parade was nice having had a pleasant ride to their town and then about 45 minutes of dead time just to visit with our guests waiting for the parade to start. After the parade we went to another small town and took in lunch at a very unique restaurant/bar, Cy's Hoof and Horn, that served great steaks, burgers, etc. and every serving was plentiful with guests purchasing their own meals. After that, a return back to Wichita for a short rest then took the group to Old Cow Town, a local attraction depicting Wichita back in the wild west days, complete with museum type displays and period buildings, gunfights, and a saloon to get a sarsaparilla. A small fee of \$6 per person was charged at this attraction which was a discounted group rate. After that, we finished the day by gathering at a nice park with a large shelter and had a cook out. Chapter members donated the food and the chapter paid for the meat. Sunday morning we triked to a small town east of Wichita that has a unique airport, Stearman Field, with a restaurant that is just a few hundred feet from the runway and taxi ways. The atmosphere in that restaurant is all about aviation and very interesting to anyone that has an interest in flying, for they have many model airplanes of all sizes, hanging all over that restaurant and a great view of small planes as they take off and land. Following breakfast the trikers said their good-byes and headed for home. The total attendance for this first Trike-About event, hosted by the Open Prairie Trikers of Wichita Ks, was close to

80 people that attended one or more of the activities.

The Open Prairie Trikers still host a Trike-about event every other year, for in Kansas, we have a lot of triking activities and sometimes it seems there just is not enough riding days to attend them all. Considering many of the members in Kansas also support some of their neighboring states and chapter events as well as National's BTW events such as the upcoming one in Deadwood, S. Dakota. Area museums have been toured over the years, unique restaurants have been visited and tourist attractions like Exploration Place, Salt Mine Museum where you descend to a working salt mine, Kansas Cosmosphere that has one of the best collection of space related memorabilia in the country, Oil Field Museum and the Keeper of the Plains Statue on the River have been viewed. Unique meals have been planned whether stopping at an Amish cafe for a home cooked like meal, to steak houses, to catered meals to picnics. Volunteers from the Chapter also functioned as guides. Meeting and picking up guests at motels when motel choices were utilized and leading them to events also takes some of the work away from the guests and gives the ride captains the opportunity to point out unique things from the community and unique routes that a local is familiar with that the usual tourist would miss.

I might add, for anyone planning an event, any event that includes group riding, if you've not been involved that much in planning a group ride, I would advise visiting with those that are experienced in doing that. There are some very important things to consider in make sure your group rides are being done in a safe manner. The Kansas BTW has compiled a Riding Safety Tips list for anyone's consideration and I'm sure that more could be added but it is a good starting point to execute a group ride from. That list is posted on the website, www.kansas-btw.org.

I believe the key to having a successful outcome for this Trike-About event is realized in three very important things: creative thinking, detailed organizing, and being a great host. Anyway, planning a trike-about is only limited by one's imagination. And in being a good host or even a good guest, I would recommend doing a little research, maybe Google some information about the do's and don'ts in being a great host. There is a lot of information on the internet that is very helpful in showing good etiquette both in being a great host and on the flip side of the coin, showing gratitude in being someone's guest. If you are a guest, attending one of these trike-about events, or any other BTW event, it is very helpful and encouraging to the hosts to let them know you had a great time at their event. The whole idea about hosting a Trike-about event is, having an event that does not require a huge investment for either, the host or the guest and spending time together developing some great friendships. There is always a cost that is tagged with doing things but with some creative thinking and planning, keeping these costs down is an important part of planning this event. Some hosting chapter members may even consider opening their homes to some their guests, saving them on their traveling costs, etc. In our BTW family of trikers it simply doesn't matter what you ride, it's the friendships you develop that are important. And being a good host or guest at any BTW event is very important. Bottom line is this, hosting any event, but especially a Trike-About, really opens the doors to opportunity to add friends to our "friends forever" list and increasing the triking activity in your community. One of the things that is so great about the BTW, you only needed a shared interest in triking to qualify for membership. It has never mattered what you rode, whether you bought something manufactured, something custom built, or built it yourself, or whether it had 2, 3 or 4 wheels it's always been about the ride and those you ride with.
