“Charlie”

A sign over Charlie's counter read “If you have to ask, why do I ride motorcycles, you would never understand my answer”. Charlie and his wife Bev owned a mower repair shop on the outskirts of our town in Ohio. His little shop grew and in a few years he built a new building and expanded the business into town. There he and Bev were very successful selling and servicing lawn & garden equipment. He also sold and installed many motorcycle accessories and serviced all bikes. Charlie was a Charter Member of the local Goldwing Chapter D3 and was instrumental in its beginning.

I had known Charlie for a long, long time; he was the oldest of 4 children, a brother Martin and sisters Donna and Carol. His parents, Stanley and Viola were good friends with my Mom and Dad as well as neighbors. They also belonged and attended the same Garden Club, Farm Bureau and Church. The sign that hung in Charlie's shop had more meaning & sentiment than most people knew or could imagine, but I understood the purpose & reason of why it was there.

Charlie started riding in his late teens when Martin picked up an old 40s style fixer-upper, an Indian. Charlie had a lot of motorcycle savvy. When it came to engine work, he could tear anything apart and make it run much better. He enjoyed all work from changing tires to fine tuning. It didn't take long for the brothers to get the old motorcycle running. Charlie and Martin took turns riding that old bike all over the community and sometimes they rode it together. Martin rode it the most because he was still in school and didn't have a job, except working on the farm with his dad.

On a late summer evening close to dusk, Marty stopped by our house to chat. He knew I loved that old bike and since he was 3 years older than me, had a motorcycle and a jalopy; he was the coolest guy around. I wanted to go for a ride but I didn't have my chores finished so I stayed home. Marty left to get gas at the closest station located only a few miles away. After filling the tank he headed home, about 3 miles away. On the last curve before the home stretch Marty took a fiery high-side when an oncoming car went left of center to miss ducks and chickens in the middle of the road. The loss of Martin was devastating to the whole community and his family was again grieving the loss of a child. Little Carol had wandered off one day at a young age and drowned in the creek behind the family's house, she was found by Charlie.

Charlie made it through those tough times and recovered. He married Bev, had children and grandchildren and operated his mower shop and accessories store. He rode his Motorcycle until his cancer was so overwhelming he could not hold it up when he stopped. Charlie loved motorcycles. He never stopped riding nor was he ever embarrassed or ashamed to explain why he rode a motorcycle. Charlie was a good father, husband and friend. He was a hard worker and good business man. I shall never forget him or the sign that hung in his shop. It is a credo that I truly understand and live by; because I had a family member that was institutionalized in a vegetative state until he died, due to a motorcycle accident at the age of 21.

TRIP TO MADERA CA

I thought it might be of some interest to tell this tale. My first trip on my trike pulling my newly restored tear-drop trailer with the wife on the seat behind me and the dog on her first trip in the trailer. Well the first good news was the dog seemed to love laying in the trailer watching the world go by and everything else we passed. The second good news was the trike was able to pull this monster over the mountains with no problem. So off we go, leaving Tucson early one morning with Jack Mertes following with his pop up trailer in tow also. Temperature is 107 F, but that's OK (are you ready?) ITS A DRY HEAT! Not much traffic and other than frequent potty stops for Jack (not the dog), we made good time,, other than for the stop in Quartsites to get Beef Jerky that Jack insists is the best he ever tasted and he stops here every trip, but after one bite, we all threw it away (must have been the heat) but we made it to Needles CA the first night no problem. We were informed by the manager of the KOA that we should get out of there early in the morning as it would be 117 F tomorrow. Now, to make the bed, forget the side tent for just one night, Lynne, me and the dog can share the trailer. Well the dog disagreed and spent the night with her back against the wall and her legs pushing me against Lynne who was squashed against the other wall in 90 F weather but the \$10 12v fan will keep us cool - RIGHT!? Needless to say we left early and climbed through the Rockies into California where I met a wonderful Highway Patrol officer who insisted that I needed to be wearing a helmet in CA and where I insisted that my monster was not a motorcycle therefore I did not, which I almost convinced him until he called his Sargent who said if it has a motorcycle plate I needed a helmet. I asked him to show me the law and after 20 minutes of looking he gave up and sent me on my way with a helmet on and a warning. Now we are in to the traffic demons of CA , where the temperature went down but the humidity went up way more than the temperature went down. so now instead of baking we are drowning in hot sweat (inside my helmet as well) We're now in the middle of the Grand Prix of CA. First we had to detour on to the oncoming side of the highway for a bridge replacement and got to see a car that didn't want to move over and drove into the washbed where the bridge was supposed to be, then we got onto the main highway from north to south and didn't know that they were evacuating southern CA. That's when it happened again, there was a screech of brakes and as we were in the middle lane of 3, we were rubber necking to see between vehicles as to where it was coming from, when a small black car with a young man driving came up from behind on the passengers side and tried to squeeze between us and the 18 wheeler in front of him and us and also just ahead of us. but there was not enough room so he quickly swerved to the right, took the soft shoulder crossed over the off ramp between the cars exiting and then back on the highway and the next time I saw him he was somehow on the outside lane passing everybody on the pullover part next to the concrete barrier. Wow! That was exiting, but hold on what's this another screech of brakes and here comes the cop car and he is going to try and get between us and the 18 wheeler which the gap is even smaller now so thank God he stopped and used his siren to try and get vehicles to get out of his road so he could continue his pursuit. Fat chance this wasn't

going to happen quickly as we were bumper to bumper and no where to go. It took him some time to get this accomplished which I guess would have allowed this young fellow to be in the next county by then. So things settled down and on we chugged for several minutes when the aliens attacking southern CA sent a missile our way, but wait a minute... it was just the police helicopter coming up from behind at about 100 ft. trying to catch up to the pursuit. That raised the hair on the back of my neck, even through all the sweat. Got through this town and off we go again, wait a minute, no we don't, seems the guy on the other side of us took off a little too fast and the vehicles in front of him only took off for about 100 feet and then stopped again much faster than him and bang, parts flying. The workers on their way home in this truck started to line the lane beside us and liked to watch our trikes go by or wanted a lift home not sure which but we are on a mission and must keep going. It is now afternoon and that cooler weather we mentioned has changed to very hot again and the sweat increases. That's when Jack passes us and signals to pull off at the next ramp, which we did knowing we didn't need gas. We were not sure why we were stopping until we caught up to Jack at the service station where he was stripping off several layers of wet clothing, and explaining that from his place behind us he first thought the cop car was coming through him and then over us during the chase. After de-watering and a cold drink off we go again, sweating along very comfortably. We made it into the beautiful Madera Fairgrounds and home for at least a few days and saw all the wonderful BTW members attending the California Trike-In. Setting up the teardrop with the attached side tent for the first time was a real experience but that's another story, but now the dog can sleep in the tent and I get my bed back. The next day we headed into Yosemite Park for a wonderful ride and spectacular scenery. We got a couple of bonuses in flood waters that had reached unheard of levels and in some cases reached over the roads and splashed us but that was OK because the weather was warm and the splash was cool. OK back to the campsite for a great dinner & bed. Up the next morning to much better weather and some fun games and dinner and awards. They are calling for possibly more bad weather for tomorrow and we have to head home. Up early and it is not bad yet so we decide to get an early start and try to beat the incoming weather. Right fat chance! Have you ever felt like you have a mad banshee on your tail and if you stop you will be devoured? Well that was it and the banshee was in the form of high winds, rain, hail and spray from the 18 wheelers, but never fear, the dog was quite content in the teardrop, watching us going in and out of the rain. OK no setting up at a campground tonite lets get a motel and relax, unanimous vote. So we get a nice quite motel and bed down for the nite with the dog on her mat at the foot of the bed.

It's 2:00 am and somebody is trying to turn a key in the door, and the dog is going crazy, but he keeps trying so I get up in my nothing and open the curtain thinking one look at this sight and he will be long gone. But no this just confuses him and he decides to inspect his key that won't work, which is when I decided he was wasted and had no idea what he was doing so I shouted get the xxxx away from the door, which he did and decided he must be on the floor above us so up the metal staircase he goes, which is right outside the walkway in front of our room, He was a very large young man and was having a great deal of trouble getting up the stairs and

AMCN Membership Terms and Conditions

AirMedCare Network is an alliance of affiliated air ambulance providers* (each a "Company"). An AirMedCare Network membership automatically enrolls you as a member in each Company's membership program. Membership ensures the patient will have no out-of-pocket flight expenses if flown by a Company by providing prepaid protection against a Company's air ambulance costs that are not covered by a member's insurance or other benefits or third party responsibility, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Patient transport will be to the closest appropriate medical facility for medical conditions that are deemed by AMCN Provider attending medical professionals to be life- or limb-threatening, or that could lead to permanent disability, and which require emergency air ambulance transport. A patient's medical condition, not membership status, will dictate whether or not air transportation is appropriate and required. Under all circumstances, an AMCN Provider retains the sole right and responsibility to determine whether or not a patient is flown.
2. AMCN Provider air ambulance services may not be available when requested due to factors beyond its control, such as use of the appropriate aircraft by another patient or other circumstances governed by operational requirements or restrictions including, but not limited to, equipment manufacturer limitations,

governmental regulations, maintenance requirements, patient condition, age or size, or weather conditions. FAA restrictions prohibit most AMCN Provider aircraft from flying in inclement weather conditions. The primary determinant of whether to accept a flight is always the safety of the patient and medical flight crews. Emergent ground ambulance transport of a member by an AMCN Provider will be covered under the same terms and conditions.

3. Members who have insurance or other benefits, or third party responsibility claims, that cover the cost of ambulance services are financially liable for the cost of AMCN Provider services up to the limit of any such available coverage. In return for payment of the membership fee, the AMCN Provider will consider its air ambulance costs that are not covered by any insurance, benefits or third party responsibility available to the member to have been fully prepaid. The AMCN Provider reserves the right to bill directly any appropriate insurance, benefits provider or third party for services rendered, and members authorize their insurers, benefits providers and responsible third parties to pay any covered amounts directly to the AMCN Provider. Members agree to remit to the AMCN Provider any payment received from insurance or benefit providers or any third party for air medical services provided by the AMCN Provider, not to exceed regular charges. Neither the Company nor AirMedCare

Network is an insurance company. Membership is not an insurance policy and cannot be considered as a secondary insurance coverage or a supplement to any insurance coverage. Neither the Company nor AirMedCare Network will be responsible for payment for services provided by another ambulance service.

4. Membership starts 15 days after the Company receives a complete application with full payment; however, the waiting period will be waived for unforeseen events occurring during such time. Members must be natural persons. Memberships are non-refundable and non-transferable.
5. Some state laws prohibit Medicaid beneficiaries from being offered membership or being accepted into membership programs. By applying, members certify to the Company that they are not Medicaid beneficiaries.

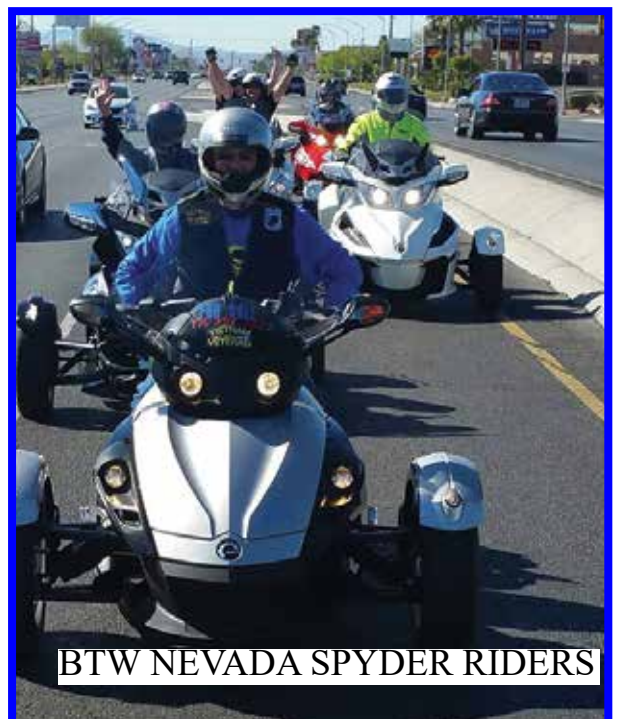

CHECK 5 BEFORE YOU RIDE

1: Tires, check your tires to make sure they are properly inflated. Every rider should know the proper PSI rating for their tires. Checking them when they are cold is best. Check them for any wear, anything embedded, broken or damaged spokes and rims, and make sure the tread is adequate.

2: Lights, Make sure all lights are in good working order. Head lights (High and Low Beam), Brake lights and Turn Signals. Check that the covers are not loose or cracked, are free of dirt and bugs, and that the bulbs are bright enough to be seen. (Always carry extra fuses.)

3: Controls. Make sure your cables are in good condition, not worn or frayed, no kinks or bends, and are securely connected. Check your clutch and brake levers, make sure they are not loose, that they pull easily and return to their proper position. Look at your brake and shifter, make sure they are attached securely, not bent, and in proper working order. Double Check Your Brakes.

4: Fluids. Check your fluids, make sure your oil level is sufficient. Improper oil level could damage your bike. Everyone should know their bikes correct oil weight, and how to check and fill it properly. Check your gas, you may have used more or forgotten to fill up after your last ride. Your boots are not made for walking.

5: Kickstand. Check that it is properly attached, not loose, wobbly or bent. You don't want to be riding down the road, look in your mirror, and see your kickstand bouncing down the road behind you.

The goal is to enjoy the ride and arrive safely.

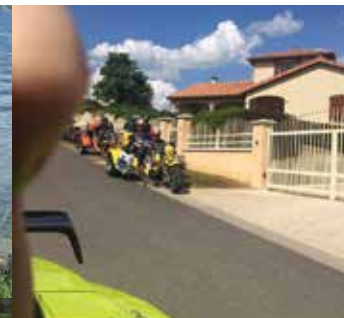

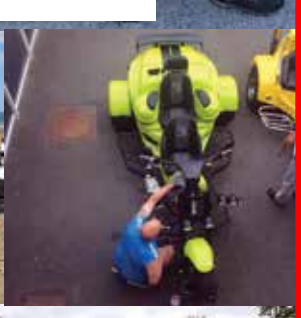

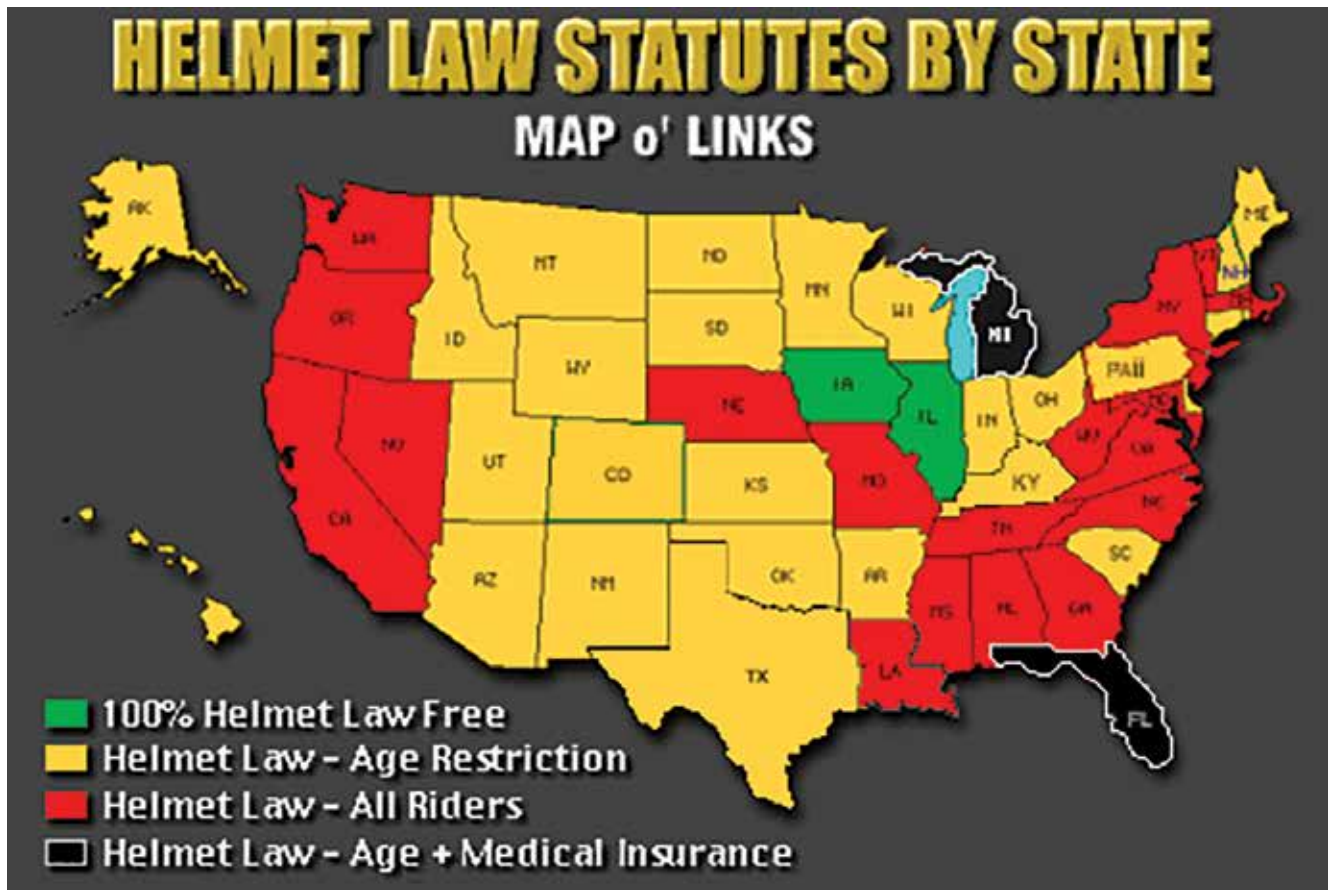

long time and dedicated member since 1995 who loved his trike and loved to ride. Leonard is with his wife now, she is riding her horse and he's chasing her on his trike.

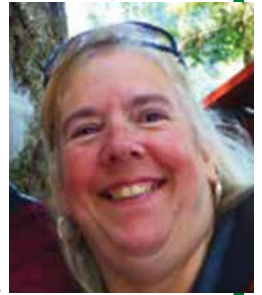
