regulations, maintenance requirements, patient condition, age or size, or weather conditions. FAA restrictions prohibit most AMCN Provider aircraft from flying in inclement weather conditions. The primary determinant of whether to accept a flight is always the safety of the patient and medical flight crews. Emergent ground ambulance transport of a member by an AMCN Provider will be covered under the same terms and conditions.

- Members who have insurance or other benefits, or third party responsibility claims, that cover the cost of ambulance services are financially liable for the cost of AMCN Provider services up to the limit of any such available coverage. In return for payment of the membership fee, the AMCN Provider will consider its air ambulance costs that are not covered by any insurance, benefits or third party responsibility available to the member to have been fully prepaid. The AMCN Provider reserves the right to bill directly any appropriate insurance, benefits provider or third party for services rendered, and members authorize their insurers, benefits providers and responsible third parties to pay any covered amounts directly to the AMCN Provider. Members agree to remit to the AMCN Provider any payment received from insurance or benefit providers or any third party for air medical services provided by the AMCN Provider, not to exceed regular charges. Neither the Company nor AirMedCare

Network is an insurance company. Membership is not an insurance policy and cannot be considered as a secondary insurance coverage or a supplement to any insurance coverage. **Neither the Company nor AirMedCare Network will be responsible for payment for services provided by another ambulance service.**

- Membership starts 15 days after the Company receives a complete application with full payment; however, the waiting period will be waived for unforeseen events occurring during such time. Members must be natural persons. Memberships are non-refundable and non-transferable.
  - Some state laws prohibit Medicaid beneficiaries from being offered membership or being accepted into membership programs. By applying, members certify to the Company that they are not Medicaid beneficiaries.
  - These terms and conditions supersede all previous terms and conditions between a member and the Company or AirMedCare Network, including any other writings, or verbal representations, relating to the terms and conditions of membership.

### CHAPTER TWO CONTINUED FROM LAST ISSUE:

It was wonderful and a blessing to be out of the city. No noise, no traffic, just the open road. We took 87 past Fountain Hill and Fort McDowell Indian Reservation. The desert wasn't anything I had ever experienced. Cactus of so many shapes, sizes, and color. Each distinct and beautiful stretching heavenward. The desert floor looked as if it had been swept by the wind. Other than the rocks and cactus it was smooth and clean. How many scorpions and snakes were sunning themselves out there as we sped by? Nothing was moving as I looked out across the wide expanse of the never ending wasteland. I was grateful that we were moving at a healthy clip so there was air stirring. Riding along at 60mph the air was so hot and dry it felt as if my skin was peeling off. How much worse it would have been with a helmet! Did I pack moisturizing cream? I decided the desert is beautiful, but I would rather experience it in January.

Our first stop on the road was the small western town of Payson, Arizona. It is a typical little western town right on the edge of the desert. The first building I saw, which we parked in front of, was an old saloon. Wooden board walk, hitching rail, and big swinging bat doors. I could just imagine the cowboys and dance hall girls walking through those doors. The music being played and beer glasses being clinked as the town went about its' business. Not so different from today really. My throat was dried like leather. Was in need of a drink of water. My hands were stiff from gripping the handle bars and my shoulder muscles were tight. When I climbed off the trike I realized my whole body was a mass of tight muscles! I must have gripped that trike with every fiber of my body! Remember this was the first time I had actually ridden a trike for any distance. To say I was anxious was an understatement! The good thing is I had found 4th gear and was able to enjoy the ride through the desert. We were ready for a break. We would like to have gone into the saloon to have a drink at the bar, put our foot on the brass foot rail, smell the saw dust on the floor, ask the bartender about the history, like who were the outlaws to frequent the establishment in the old days. BUT, it was closed and open for tours only. We got drinks from the antique store vending machine. We didn't have time to wait for the tour so we readied to start out again. Now that I think about it, didn't Louis L'Amour say the Sacketts had traveled through Payson a number of times? OK, it was in a book! They were real to me! As we walked to the trikes, listening to the sound of our boots on the wood walk, Lee pointed in the distance ahead." See that mountain? That is where we are going!" he said. My heart skipped several beats. I stopped breathing! If it looks that high from here, what would it be close up? All I could think was, what if I couldn't shift into the right gear going up that mountain? What I said was, "Let's go!" Lee said later he expected a bit more excitement since it was my first mountain. I was afraid, but

I wish I could describe the mountain, but I was afraid the trike would bog down... afraid of the corners because I would need to shift... afraid that the ditches were ravines and went down forever! I prayed the trike wouldn't stall because there was nothing but mountain on one side and ravine on the other. Somehow I traveled the entire way in 2nd gear. Did you know it is possible to go 7400 feet without breathing?

We were almost to the top of the mountain when we reached Clint Wells. Clint Wells is a mountain restaurant that Lee assured me makes the best hamburgers. Surrounded by the Coconino National Forest, the restaurant's rustic exterior lent to the comfortable feel of the place. There were no neon signs in the window or chain name attached. Just the type of homey place that makes me feel welcome. I had been aware as we climbed the mountain of the change in temperature. When we parked the trikes I actually felt a chill. What a change from the desert! As I climbed off the trike I realized how tired and hungry I was. It had been a long, fun, yet stressful ride and I was ready to set down on something that didn't move. I was so ready for one of those tasty hamburgers Lee had bragged about. As we stepped through the door all 5 people present said hello, then went back to their conversation. The interior was as rustic as the outside. One room with a wooden floor, log walls, tables and chairs, and yes a wooden counter. Small windows looked out into the forest. The ride out of Phoenix with all its' challenges was worth it just to be sitting in this perfect, tranquil, mountain shelter in the forest. I realized just how hungry I was when I walked through the door and smelled all that heavenly, greasy food. We placed our orders of deluxe hamburgers, fries, coffee, and for me a chocolate malt. I had eaten half my breakfast hours ago and I was hungry!

What I like most about a small down home restaurant is that the local people are genuinely friendly. They make you feel welcome. We exchanged current news, where you from, where you going? And the one question I would come to expect where ever we stopped was, "What are those things you riding?" The waitress was originally from Madison and knew people from Westfield. Her connection was a girlfriend whose family had a cabin in the area. Big world but, no matter where you travel someone knows someone you know or been where you have been. That it was nice to connect with home through a stranger. Lee was correct on the food. It was good and hardy Northwoods fare and it hit the spot. The hamburger was "real" hamburger measured by hand, slapped in the pan in a generous mound. Fries golden brown with just the right amount of grease. The malt was "real ice cream!"

Before we got ready to leave, I asked Lee directions to the bathroom. He pointed to a door behind our table. Opening the door I stepped out into the woods. We all made sure we did our business before he got in there, because he wouldn't come out any time soon. This one on the mountain was a 2 holer. No books. No catalogs. As I sat there I wondered how I should play this when I went back in? I am sure Lee was waiting for my reaction when I walked back in. I did my business, returned with a straight face and said, "Ready to go?"

As we got on our trikes to leave, I looked at the restaurant feeling sad I wouldn't be coming back this way. With tummy full all I wanted to do was take a hot shower, put on sweats, and enjoy an early evening around the campfire. Lee said the campground was just up the road. We were both ready to call it a day.

The Coconino Forest is beautiful and peaceful. What these trees must have seen over their life time. Wouldn't it be great to hear the tales they could tell? Was it the elevation that made the trees so green? So many shades of greens as the sun traveled over them. Cruising along at peace with the world, noble pines towering over the road, could there be a more majestic place on earth? Suddenly, to the left I caught a quick movement out of the corner of my eye. What happened next is as crystal clear 16 years later as it was then. It all occurred quickly but in slow motion. Out from the ditch came a big gray squirrel running full tilt right toward Lee's trike. It all happened so suddenly I didn't have time to yell. This won't end well, I thought! Just as the squirrel was about to hit the wheel, he went straight up on his front legs and hung there with tail waving in the breeze like a flag! And then he was gone! I didn't even see him go. I started to snicker and then laugh. Did I really see what I saw? Did Lee see it? When we pulled into the campground Lee was laughing. He had seen that crazy squirrel. Can you imagine the story that squirrel had to tell when he got home? After telling them what happened his wife probably had this to say..... "George I told you not to play that silly game! Some day you will be grease on the road! The kids were probably excited to think old dad was a hero, asking him over and over to tell them again how close he came to the tire and how long he stood tall in the wind just inches from that tire. I liked her! Something was changing without the pressures of home on my shoulders. I was not yet ready to look, too closely, at the reasons for this discomfort. It was enough to feel free for a while.

As we were packing up and tightening the bungee cords on the luggage and tents, I started feeling nervous. The excitement and culmination of months of planning, hadn't given me time to worry about what lay ahead. Suddenly, I started to doubt what I was doing. Again, the thought that I didn't have a motorcycle license, or insurance weighed on me. What if we get stopped? I hadn't seen my trike constructed, I simply trusted Lee. Was it road worthy for such a long trip? I started to worry about shifting gears, giving it too much gas, or not enough gas! Would I kill it at a stop sign embarrassing myself? Heaven knows we were always the center of attention! I didn't like this feeling of apprehension.

After leaving Clint Wells, we headed toward Winslow, Arizona. Highway 87 was good, smooth pavement. Cruising along at 60-70 miles per hour, gave me the opportunity to look at the scenery. I am still amazed how much you see while on a trike. The smells, sounds, colors, little changes in the landscape, you aren't aware of in a vehicle. Now, I can't imagine going up a mountain or crossing the desert on anything but a trike. The air was clear and fresh at this altitude. Maybe it was due to this being new to me, that I couldn't get enough of the redwoods, pinions, and rock formations. The trees were twisted, and bent with the winds of time. If only they could tell us what they have seen. Some so old they must have seen a wagon train or two. The colors were vibrant earth tones of browns, tans, rusts and greens. I know, "Just how vibrant cans tans and browns be?" This being the first time on a trike, the colors, textures and tones were more visible to my eye. We couldn't even get static on the radios. We never did get them working, which was fine with me. I wanted to ride, not talk. I think Lee wanted them so he could keep track of me. I had a habit of stopping to take pictures. Lee would be way down the road, before he realized I wasn't behind him. Once, I took three pictures of a beautiful red rock formation, from three different sides. Lee laughed and said, "Those pictures will all look alike when they are developed!" He was right! Actually I couldn't pick them out from all the other "beautiful" formations I had taken. Memory is so much better!

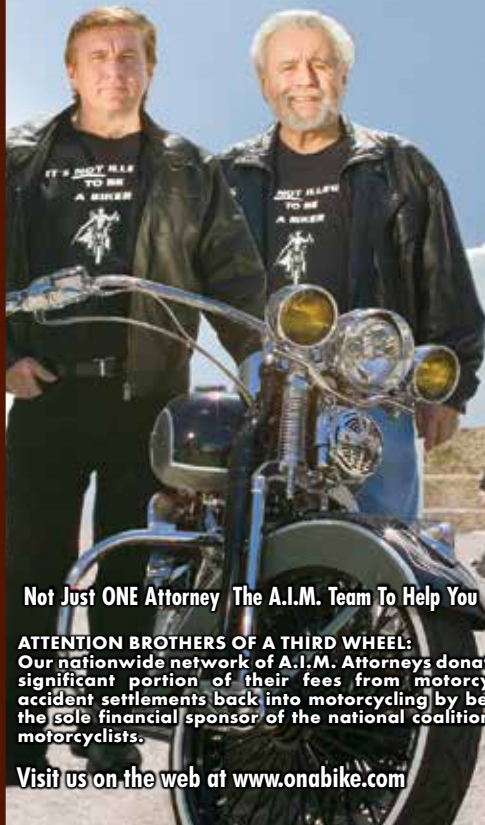

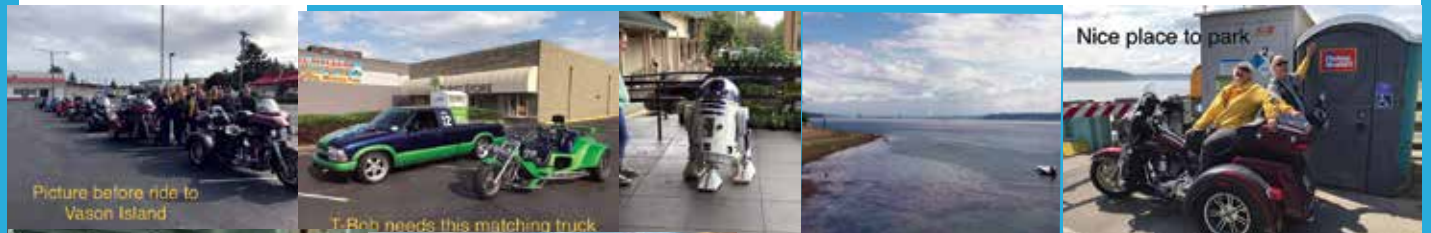

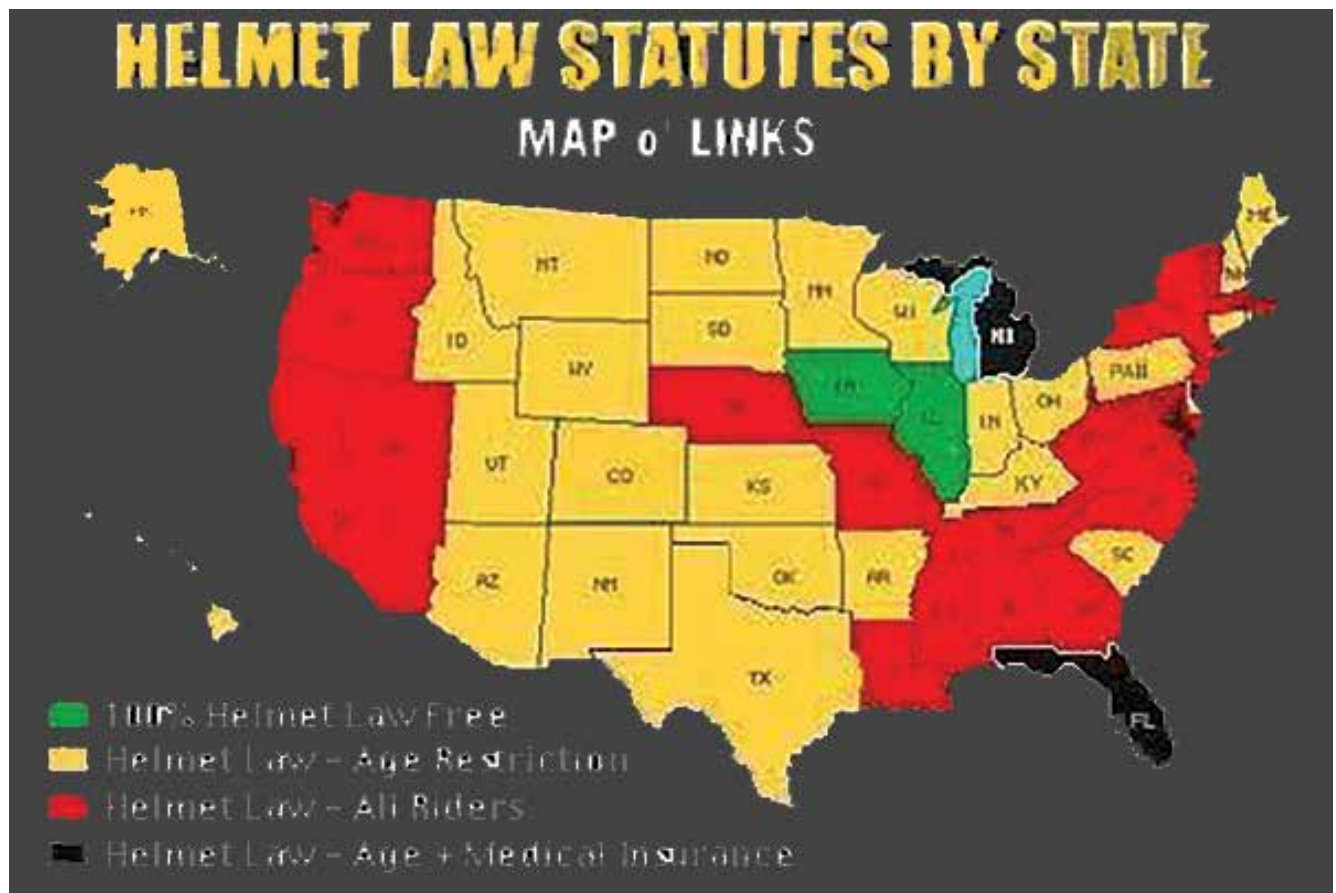

## MOTORCYCLE HAND SIGNALS



**Left turn**  
Arm and hand extending left, palm facing down



**Right turn**  
Arm out, bent at 90° angle, fist clenched.



**Stop**  
Arm extended straight down, palm facing back.



**Speed Up**  
Arm extended straight out, palm facing up, swing upward.



**Slow Down**  
Arm extended straight out, palm facing down, swing down to your side.



**Follow Me**  
Arm extended straight up from shoulder, palm forward.



**You Lead/Come**  
Arm extended upward 45°, palm forward pointing with index finger, swing in arc from back to front.



**Hazard in Roadway**  
On the left, point with left hand; on the right, point with right foot.



**Single File**  
Arm and index finger extended straight up.



**Double File**  
Arm with index and middle finger extended straight up.



**Comfort Stop**  
Forearm extended, fist clenched with short up and down motion.



**Refreshment Stop**  
Fingers closed, thumb to mouth.



**Turn Signal On**  
Open and close hand with fingers and thumb extended.



**Pull Off**  
Arm positioned as for right turn, forearm swung toward shoulder.



**Cops Ahead**  
Tap on top of helmet with open palm down.



**Fuel**  
Arm out to side pointing to tank with finger extended.

## **BTW BOD Elections**
