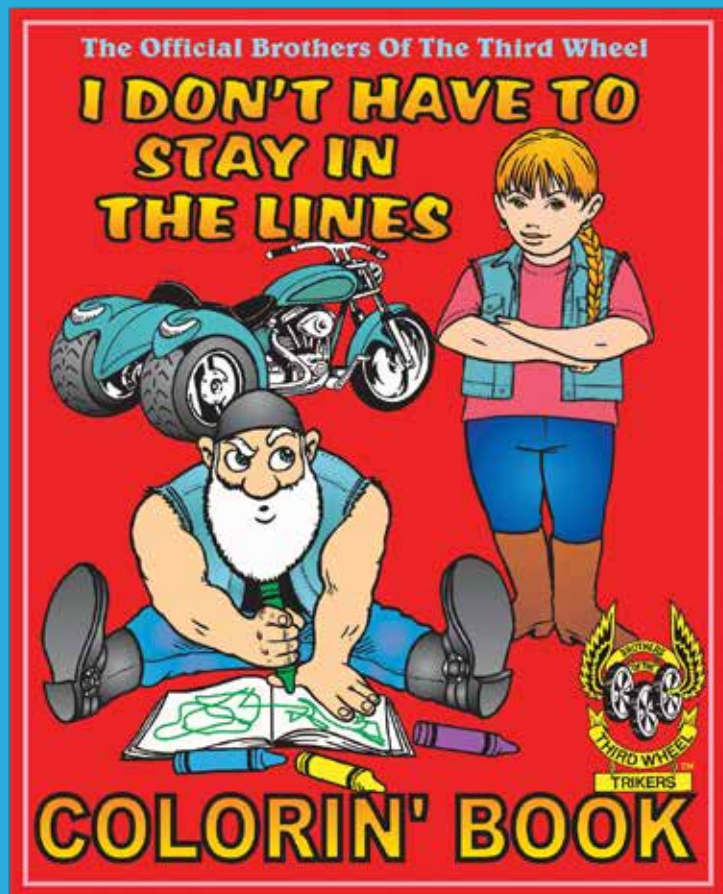

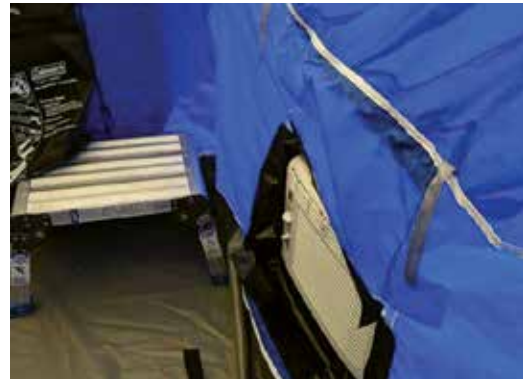

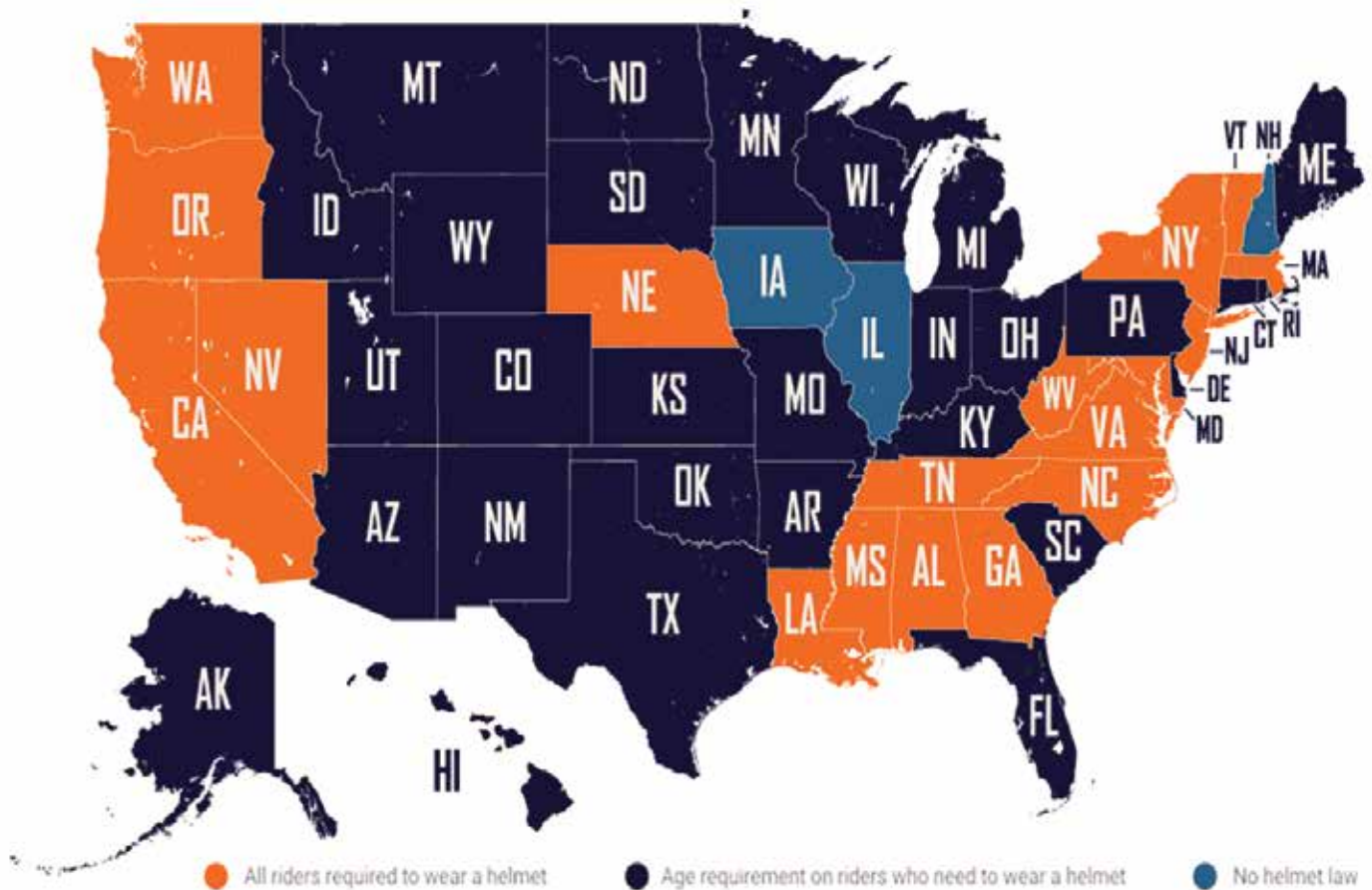

EACH PHONE SETTING IS DIFFERENT, HOWEVER YOUR SERVICE PROVIDER CAN HELP WITH HOW THAT IS DONE. A SETTING OF 150 PIXELS IS GOOD AND 200 PIXELS WILL GIVE YOU A BEAUTIFUL PHOTO, THAT WILL NOT BE GRAINY AND THE COLORS WILL BE TRUE AND SHARP. PHOTOS THAT WE RECEIVE AT HQ IN 72 PIXELS ARE RUN THROUGH A PROGRAM TO CLEAN THEM UP BUT NOT MUCH HAPPENS AS THE BASE IS SO LOW THAT THE PROGRAM CAN ONLY LIGHTEN OR DARKEN THEM. THIS IS JUST A TIP SO WE CAN POST BETTER PICTURES IN THE MAGAZINE TO MAKE YOUR TRIKE LOOK ITS BEST AND OF COURSE YOU AS WELL. HOWEVER IN MY CASE IT WOULD TAKE MORE THAN MORE PIXELS TO MAKE ME LOOK GOOD

2024 CENTRAL STATES TRIKE-IN

Another Central States Trike-In is in the books. This year, 28 people gathered in Perryville, Missouri, June 5 – 8, for this annual event. Attendees came in from Missouri, Illinois, Arkansas, California and Tennessee.

We had a last-minute change of venue due to our original location suddenly deciding they didn't want bikes on-site as well as quadrupling the facility rental fee. Fortunately, we were able to rent a pavilion in the Perryville city park. As a follow-up to the original venue issue, we subsequently received word that the person who caused the issues has since been terminated by that facility.

Perryville is in southeast Missouri, approximately 75 miles south of St. Louis. It features a replica of the Vietnam memorial wall as well as other veteran oriented attractions and is very biker oriented. Southwestern Illinois is conveniently reachable via a bridge across the Mississippi River that connects to Chester, IL, which is the hometown of E.C. Segar, the creator of Popeye.

The June 6 ride had a destination of Bald Knob Cross in Alto Pass, IL, via a lunch stop at 17th Street BBQ in Murphysboro, IL. Alto Pass is located within the Shawnee National Forest and the cross is located on one of the highest points in the state of Illinois, so the vistas are spectacular. The ride back to Perryville detoured south to cross the Mississippi at Cape Girardeau, MO for a round trip of approximately 140 miles.

The June 8 ride headed over to Fort de Chartres, a French colonial fort in Prairie du Rocher, Il. The day started out rainy so departure was delayed until the rain cleared out. We took the scenic route, crossing the bridge to Chester, IL and heading north to Waterloo, Il before cutting over Bluff Road which runs along the base of massive limestone bluffs overlooking the Mississippi River. 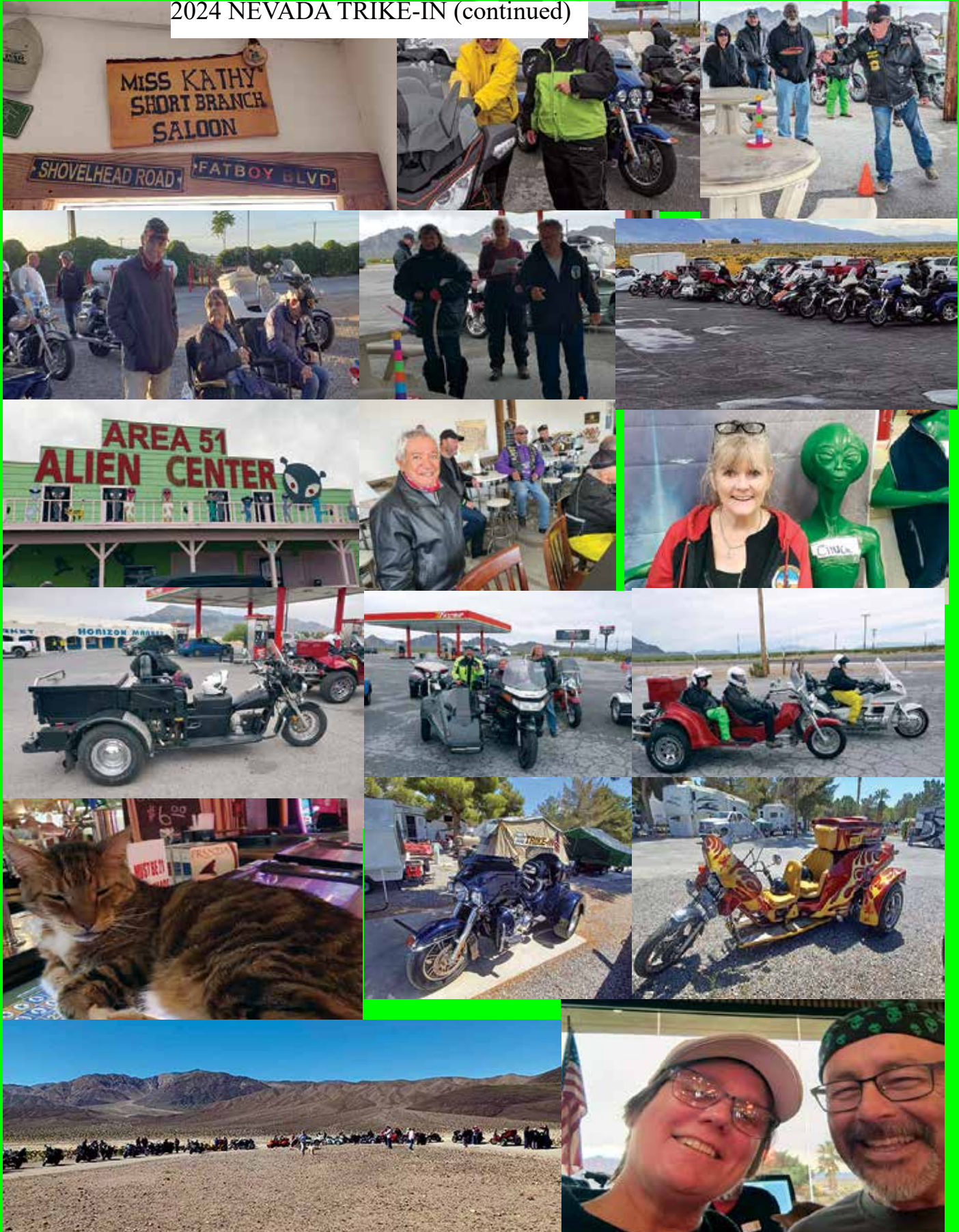

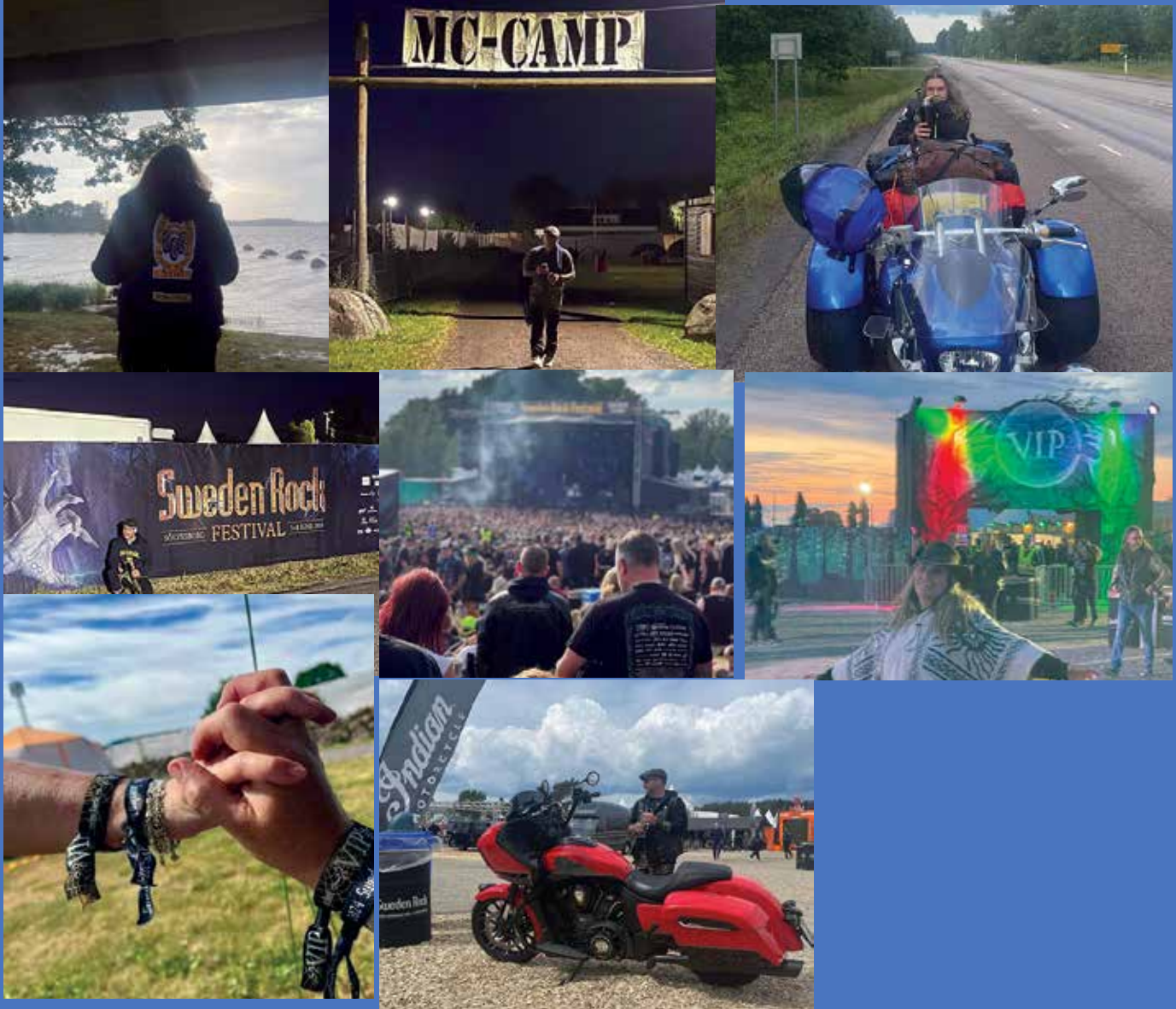

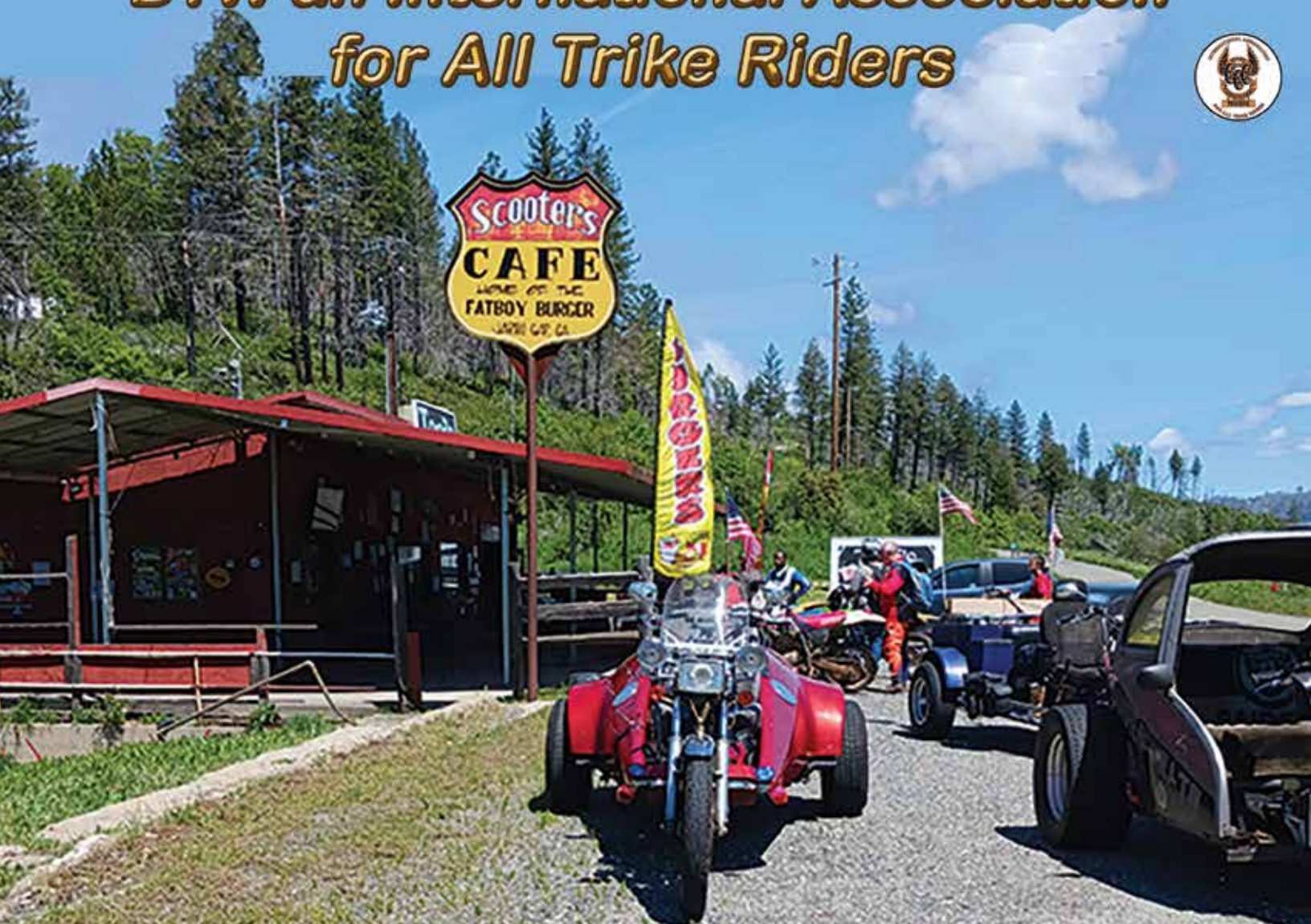
