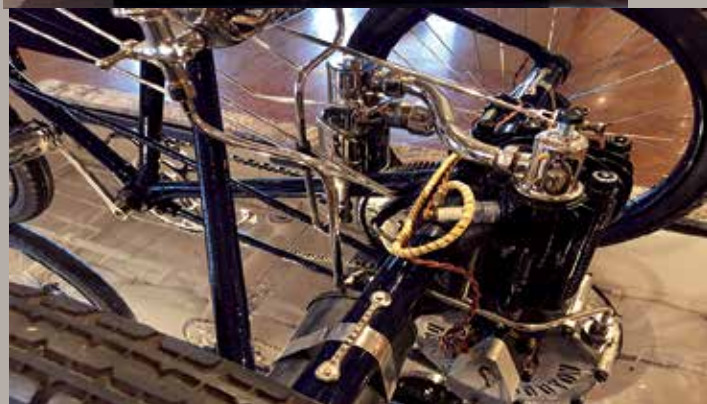
Of particular interest to BTW Trikers are two trikes dating back to 1899 and 1903.
