Kingston-Alpine Weekend on the Niken GT

Despite COVID-19 many of us took part in the annual ride from Tucson, AZ to Kingston, NM and Alpine, AZ on the last extended weekend in September last year. To organizer, Craig Littlefield's credit, he arranged outdoor dinners at each location and outdoor breakfast/lunch options along the way. In all, about 19 people would converge in at least one of the nightly destinations, and ten of us met at I-10 and Wilmot Road for the trek east to Safford, AZ for breakfast. Some guys packed a breakfast and enjoyed it at a park in town. Against our better judgement, Dean Hurt, Mark Grosvenor and I went to perpetually-understaffed Jerry's for a leisurely breakfast.

Craig thought we could meet back up with the rest of the group at the Mule Creek Pass overlook, but they had less tolerance for Jerry's slow service than we did. The three of us



still enjoyed the best curves of the day before heading south on US180 to Silver City, NM. We neglected to top off our tanks before turning up twisty NM152 to remote Kingston, 45 miles away. We became separated traversing the numerous switchbacks and tight curves along the scenic mountain road. Dean missed the turn off to the Black Range Lodge when his GPS lost its

signal, so he rode more of NM152 than he cared to on the big Indian Roadmaster. Black Range Lodge owner, Gary had a 5 gallon can of gas that he shared with Dean and me so we didn't have to walk back to Silver City the next morning.



We enjoyed beer and local Black Range wine to kick off happy hour around 5 PM. We all chipped in for homemade pizza served outside in the shade on a perfect evening nestled in the mountains. Gary gave some of us a tour of a straw house and outdoor stage on the property at dusk.

The next morning breakfast was served at 7 AM in the same area and by 8 AM we were rolling back down NM152 as a group on a pleasantly cool morning. I worked my way through the group on the three-wheeled Niken GT and followed Keith Holcroft down to NM35, where I took the lead. Dean continued down 152 to Silver City and most of the group headed north on NM15 to Gila Cliff Dwellings as Mark and I head south on 15 for another missed rendezvous with Dean in Silver City.

We caught up with Dean at the Whitewater Canyon Catwalk, off US180 in Glenwood, NM. We hiked almost a mile along the paths and catwalk over running water, getting our exercise for the day, or in my case knee replacement physical therapy. Further north we turned toward Reserve, NM for a cold beer at Uncle Bill's Bar and a late lunch at Dean's favorite, Ella's Café. The green chili cheeseburger hit the spot. We rode the seven miles back to US180 for what is arguably the most fun and scenic final stretch of the road into Alpine, AZ.

Some of us had rooms at the Mountain Hi Lodge and most of the group had rooms at the Sportsman Lodge, where I joined the second happy hour gathering of the trip after checking Craig had reserved tables for 16 of us under a tent at the Foxfire for dinner on another beautiful mountain evening. We ran into Dirk Schneider and a group of his friends at an adjacent table. Party time!



The next morning smaller groups departed for home mostly between 7-8 AM. Dean, Mark and I rolled out about 7:45 AM with the temperature at 57 in Alpine. Shortly after turning west on curvy Three Forks Road the temp dropped to 46 briefly before warming back up by Big Lake. It was refreshing, with the proper gear and grip heaters. The early morning sun hit the vibrant yellow Aspens along both sides of the road, as another reminder that fall had already arrived in the high country.

The plan was to have breakfast at Darbi's Café in Pinetop, AZ but the place was packed when we rolled in a 9 AM. We settled on a BK Croissanwich next door, before filling up and continuing our descent south on AZ 73 through Whiteriver to AZ 77. One of my favorite stretches of the trip is the Salt River Canyon and the road carved through rock leading to it. Traffic was moderate but not surprising for a late Sunday morning. I managed to get in front of the worst of it, run to the bottom, turn around and do it again! Dean referred to me as an Adrenalin Junkie on the leaning three-wheeled Niken GT.



It warmed up as the day progressed and the elevation decreased. It was still only 87 as we rode through Globe for the last set of curves for the day, but hit 100 briefly for the first



time all weekend just outside of Winkelman. It was a warm but reasonably comfortable 95 with 10% humidity when I arrived home at 1:30 in the afternoon with a smile on my face and over 800 mi. behind me.

BTW BOD Elections

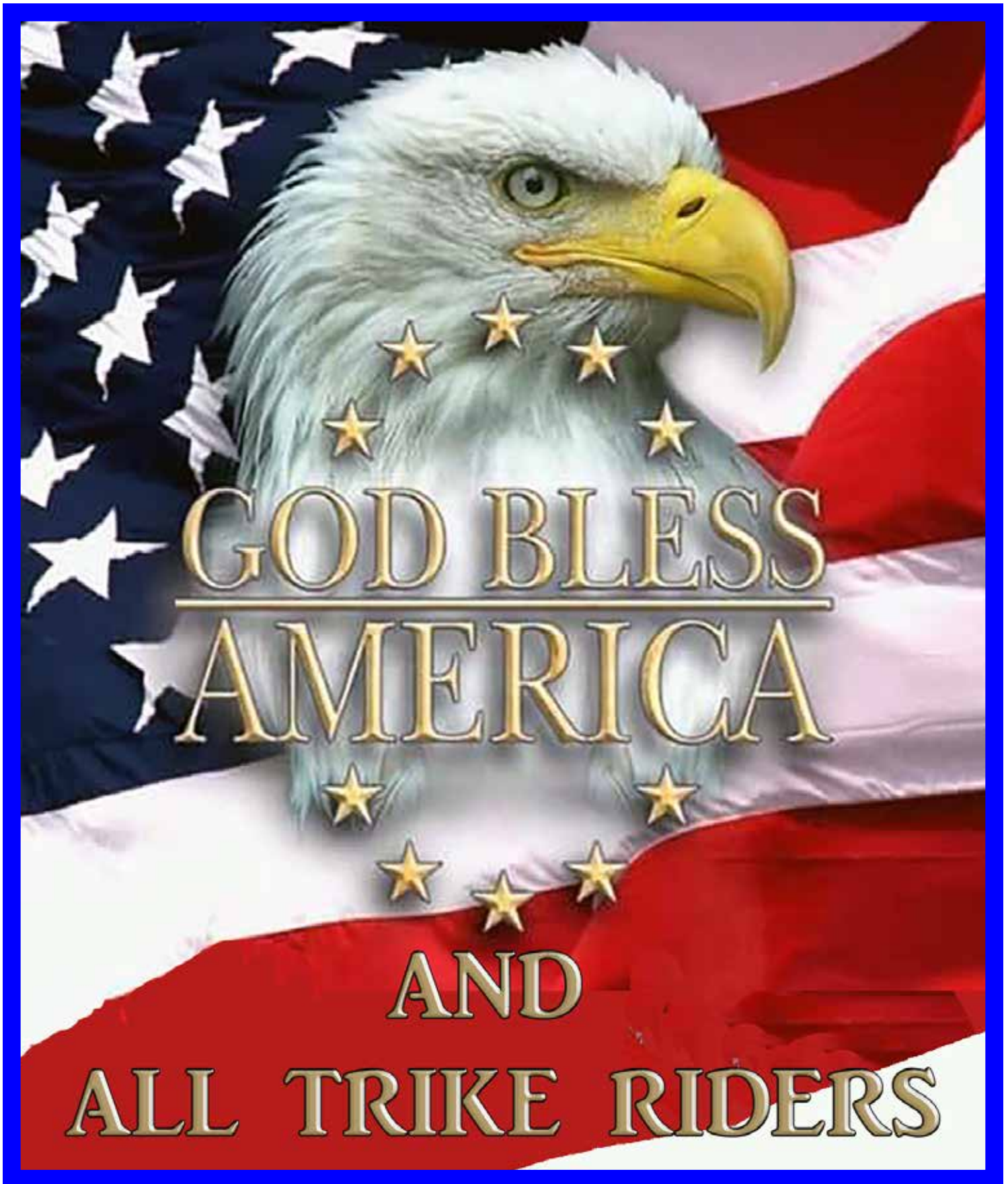
If it is your Region's turn to vote for your Director, have your Chapter or State Director contact HQ and get the documentation for the election.
