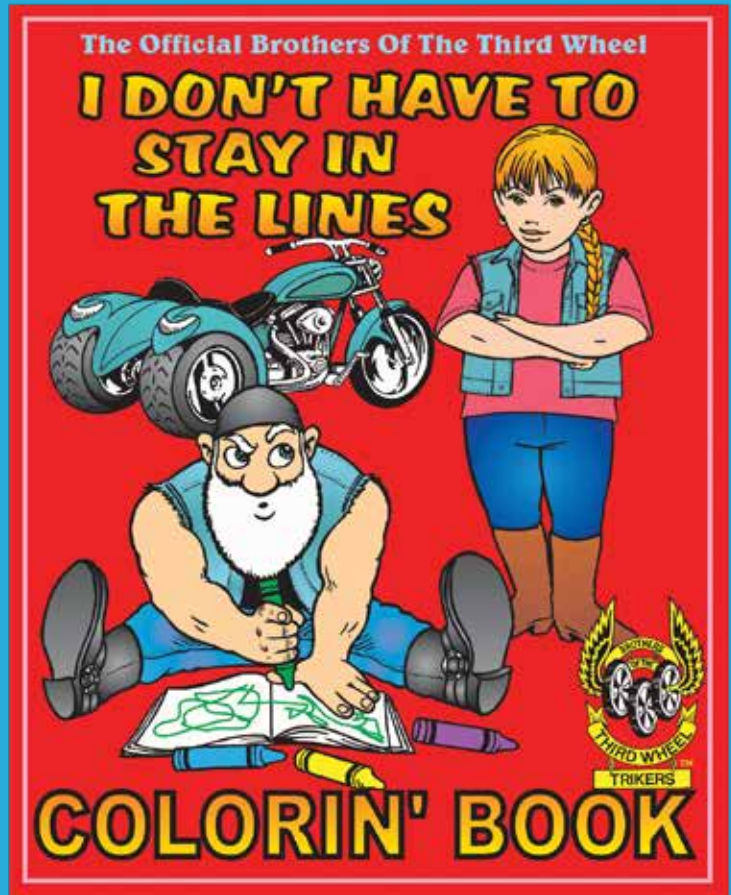

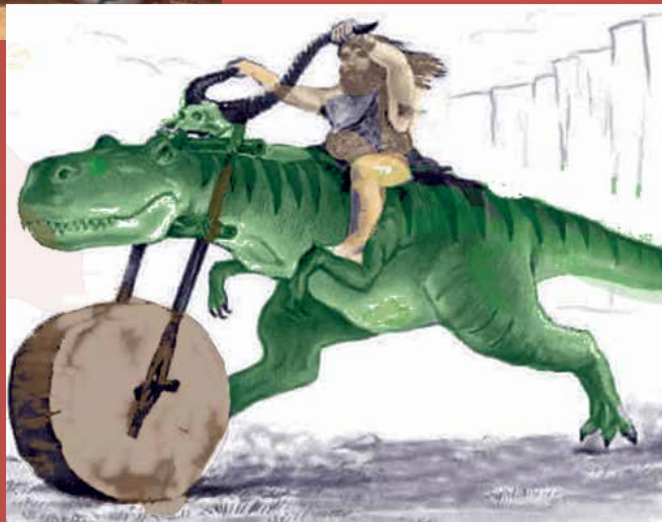

Debbie and I found a spot near the door and were amazed to see a 3-wheeled Niken, just like ours, parked adjacent to us. 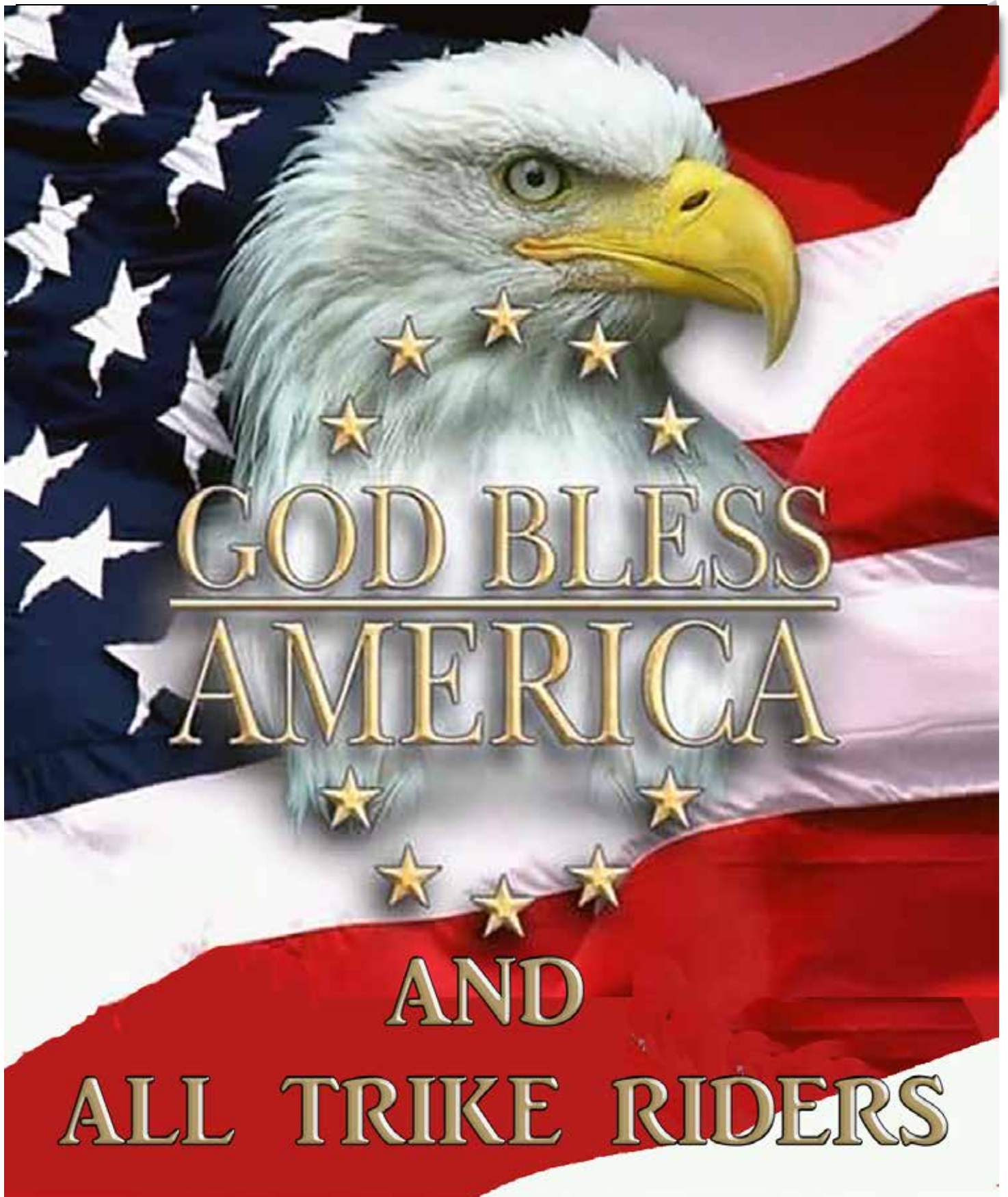

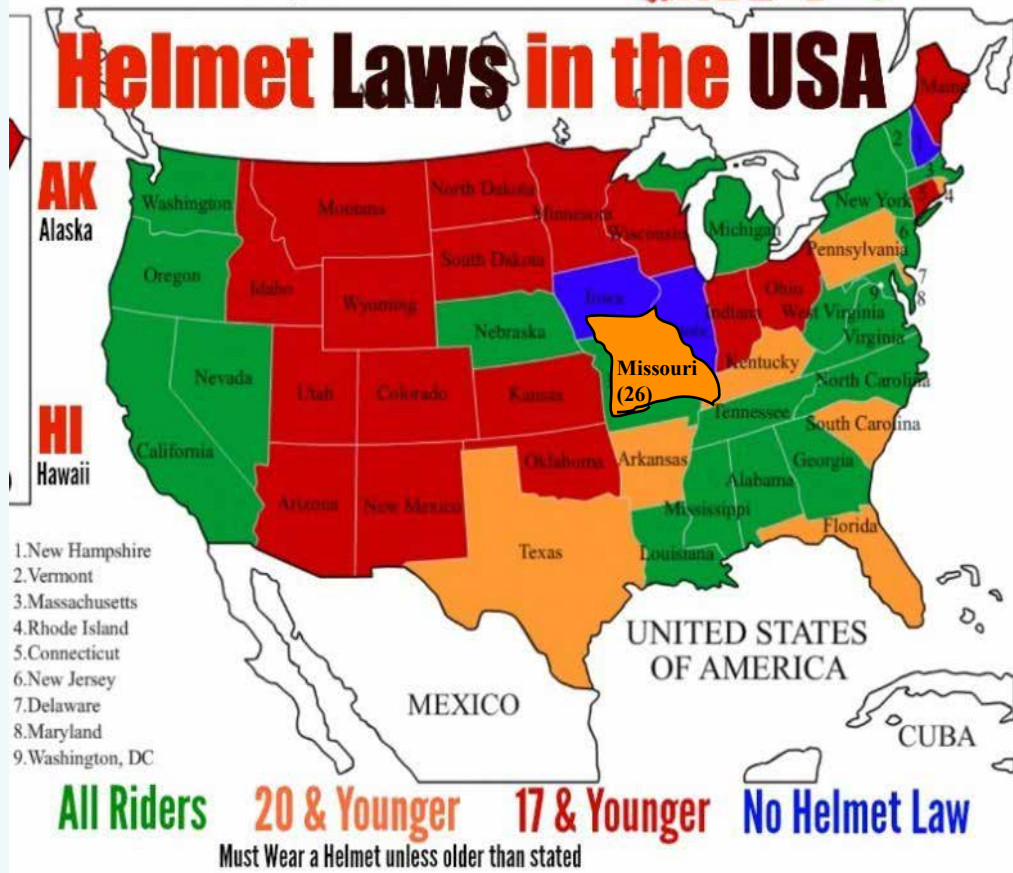

Robert Joseph Drake passed away on January 18, 2022

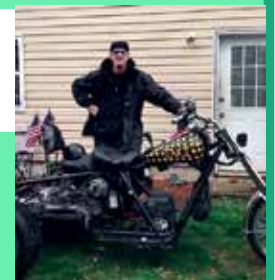

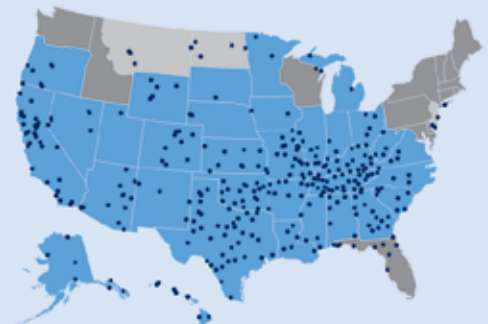

BTW BOD Elections
