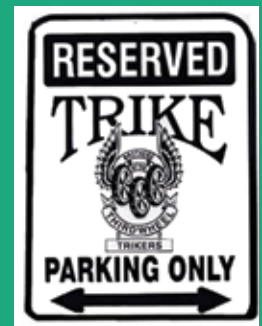

### AMCN Membership Terms and Conditions

AirMedCare Network is an alliance of affiliated air ambulance providers\* (each a "Company"). An AirMedCare Network membership automatically enrolls you as a member in each Company's membership program. Membership ensures the patient will have no out-of-pocket flight expenses if flown by a Company by providing prepaid protection against a Company's air ambulance costs that are not covered by a member's insurance or other benefits or third party responsibility, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Patient transport will be to the closest appropriate medical facility for medical conditions that are deemed by AMCN Provider attending medical professionals to be life- or limb-threatening, or that could lead to permanent disability, and which require emergency air ambulance transport. A patient's medical condition, not membership status, will dictate whether or not air transportation is appropriate and required. Under all circumstances, an AMCN Provider retains the sole right and responsibility to determine whether or not a patient is flown.
2. AMCN Provider air ambulance services may not be available when requested due to factors beyond its control, such as use of the appropriate aircraft by another patient or other circumstances governed by operational requirements or restrictions including, but not limited to, equipment manufacturer limitations, governmental

regulations, maintenance requirements, patient condition, age or size, or weather conditions. FAA restrictions prohibit most AMCN Provider aircraft from flying in inclement weather conditions. The primary determinant of whether to accept a flight is always the safety of the patient and medical flight crews. Emergent ground ambulance transport of a member by an AMCN Provider will be covered under the same terms and conditions.

3. Members who have insurance or other benefits, or third party responsibility claims, that cover the cost of ambulance services are financially liable for the cost of AMCN Provider services up to the limit of any such available coverage. In return for payment of the membership fee, the AMCN Provider will consider its air ambulance costs that are not covered by any insurance, benefits or third party responsibility available to the member to have been fully prepaid. The AMCN Provider reserves the right to bill directly any appropriate insurance, benefits provider or third party for services rendered, and members authorize their insurers, benefits providers and responsible third parties to pay any covered amounts directly to the AMCN Provider. Members agree to remit to the AMCN Provider any payment received from insurance or benefit providers or any third party for air medical services provided by the AMCN Provider, not to exceed regular charges. Neither the Company nor AirMedCare

Network is an insurance company. Membership is not an insurance policy and cannot be considered as a secondary insurance coverage or a supplement to any insurance coverage. **Neither the Company nor AirMedCare Network will be responsible for payment for services provided by another ambulance service.**

4. Membership starts 15 days after the Company receives a complete application with full payment; however, the waiting period will be waived for unforeseen events occurring during such time. Members must be natural persons. Memberships are non-refundable and non-transferable.
  5. Some state laws prohibit Medicaid beneficiaries from being offered membership or being accepted into membership programs. By applying, members certify to the Company that they are not Medicaid beneficiaries.
  6. These terms and conditions supersede all previous terms and conditions between a member and the Company or AirMedCare Network, including any other writings, or verbal representations, relating to the terms and conditions of membership.

What I did have was 15 minutes riding time in a parking lot, which didn't allow me to shift out of 1st gear.....Even if I knew how to shift out of 1st gear! And, of course, there is the blind enthusiasm of one, who thank

God, didn't say, "What could go wrong?" The months of planning and building of the trike was about to launch me into a world I had never been in. I was a Motorcycle Mamma, on my own ride! BUT, let me digress to the events leading up to this historic moment.

Anyone who lives in Wisconsin, in winter, knows that February is a real downer. Day dreams of sandy beaches, warm breezes and no long underwear is paramount. Add to that I was feeling depressed, penned in and in need of change. It's call cabin fever! One day while pouring out my heart to Aunt Irene she suggested I take a trip to visit her son Lee in Arizona. She assured me, he would welcome a visit. After thinking about it, and lots of encouragement from Aunt Irene, I decided it would be good to get away from the cold. I was hesitant to call Lee, after all, we hadn't seen one another in many years. What if we had nothing to say to one another? A week is a long time to spend in an awkward situation. I had read all the seed catalogs I could handle, nothing on television, and my mood was still bad, so I gave Lee a call. I should have known, while I was making up my mind, Aunt Irene had already contacted him. He was excited to have family visit and promised lots of sightseeing and NO snow drifts. Little did I know that a simple decision to take a vacation would put into motion changes that would have repercussions for years. The time spent on the road was much more than sightseeing, it was alone time spent on the trike thinking. Funny how jumbled thoughts find an organized rhythm when riding. Even now, years later, when I think back to that trip a peace settles over me.

I need not have been concerned about meeting a long lost cousin. The moment I landed at Sky Harbour Airport, in Phoenix, and saw Lee waiting, I knew it would be a good week. Lee looked just like his dad. That alone put me at ease. His welcoming smile did the rest. I could feel the warm air as we walked to the parking lot. It was a slice of heaven after the cold of Wisconsin. Oh yes, I can really get into this! Lee didn't have a car so he had borrowed one from a friend. As we left Sky Harbour Airport, I rolled down the window and breathed in the sunshine. The tension in my shoulders started to release. About four days into the week, while we were out riding, it dawned on me that, "I COULD RIDE A TRIKE ON MY OWN!" I could actually be in the driver's seat! What a revelation that was! It took me completely by surprise. That probably wouldn't have been a consideration back home.

I wasn't fond of the heat in Arizona, no matter how nice it was to be warm, but I loved being in a new place, meeting new people. The opportunity of being in new surroundings was exciting. As the week wore down I started thinking of going home to snowbanks and long underwear. No more frying eggs on the sidewalk! Lee laughed because the temperature was 20 degrees cooler than normal. I was toasting in the sun while others thought it was chilly. It was such a great time with Lee. We had caught up on family gossip and had gotten to know one another. I was feeling refreshed and relaxed, but it was time to pack my suitcase and fly home.

## Chapter 2

When I had called my cousin Lee, after my visit to his home in Phoenix, asking him to have a trike built for me, he hesitantly reminded me of one little problem... ".how would I get it back to Wisconsin?" No problem.... we quickly decided a road trip was in order. We would plan it around the family reunion to be held in Iowa.

After four months of conferring long distance on best routes to travel, time lines, sites to see, departure dates, supplies needed, here we were on June 18, 1996, at 9:00a.m. in sunny Phoenix, Arizona. Our bags were secured on the trikes along with tents, camp stove, pots and pans, coffee pot, food and extra parts in case we might need them. "I couldn't believe this was really happening!" My heart was pumping fast, stomach doing flip flops as I climbed aboard and settled down on the seat. I fired up the 1600cc VW engine and thought... "NO WAY OUT NOW!"

I was scared thinking about riding down Indian School Road during a busy traffic hour. I just wanted to be gone out of Phoenix. I envisioned all lights green, cruising in 4th gear, if I could find 4th, and right out of traffic into the desert. Lee had other plans! First stop was at Denny's for breakfast. I could have forgone eating since my stomach was in knots! Really had no room for food while my stomach was churning like a field of flitting butterflies. Lee reminded me we wouldn't be eating until reaching Clint Wells late in the afternoon. SO I ordered eggs, hash browns, bacon, toast and coffee. The coffee tasted wonderful. It was my first cup of the day. When the food arrived I instantly turned green! Not sure what shade, but

it sure caught Lee's attention. "Are you ok," he asked? "I will be fine." I said. Have you ever noticed people use the word "fine" when they don't really want to say how they feel? Two weeks ahead of me on the road, with a trike I hadn't become friends with as yet, and it was my only way back home. I had to be ok. I was relieved when we left the restaurant. I thought, "Yes, now we are on our way!" Pulling out of the parking lot in 1st gear, holding my breath, crossed 3 lanes of traffic, and turned left. Was actually able to shift into 2nd gear before Lee signals another left turn. Back across 4 lanes of traffic pulling into yet another parking lot. Lee needed to make a trike insurance payment. NOW why couldn't he have done that yesterday!! Leaving the insurance office we, again, crossed 4 lanes of traffic, took a left, shifted in to 2nd, had trouble with 3rd, and was about to try 4th, when Lee AGAIN signaled left. Doesn't he do any business on the right side of the street? Back across 3 lanes into Carl's Custom Volkswagen parking lot. Lee needed a pulley for his generator. "Again, REALLY, couldn't he have done this yesterday?" My shoulders were tight, I was ready to scream. I was still afraid I would get caught in traffic and not be able to shift. Leaving Phoenix was becoming a long drawn out affair. Half the day was already gone.

Leaving Carl's, I noticed by some miracle, there wasn't any traffic, so I revved up the trike, gave it gas and went across 4 lanes of traffic in a wheelie which would have made a veteran biker give a THUMBS UP! I was so surprised I forgot to lay off the gas. Still in a wheelie I turned left and finally brought it back down on all three. It wasn't till then that it dawned on me that a 1600cc Volkswagen engine in a trike with 3 wheels could pack quite a wallop! No more stops, Lee promised. OK we are finally really on our way. We must be out of town in a few more blocks? Surely the desert can't be too far away? I had only seen the desert from the plane both times I had flown into Phoenix. I was anxious to ride through it. Everyone I had talked with, who had been to the desert, said there is nothing quite like the fragrance of the desert floor. I wanted to experience it for myself. Not that I was looking forward to the heat! The light ahead was green, and HURRAY I was finally in 4th gear! By the way, all the lights had been green so far. Lee had said that it was a miracle on its own. We were approaching Hayden and Indian School Road when I smelled something hot. Glancing back I noticed smoke coming from the back of the trike. I hailed Lee and pulled into a McDonald's parking lot. My heart sank! Would my trike be ride able? How long would this delay take and how much would it cost me? Lee took a look. Decided the wiring was toast and headed for a hardware store. Between the new wires and the supplies Lee had brought with him, in two hours, he had the trike wired and we were on our way. Lee never complained about the heat while being out in the hot sun. Me, I was in and out of McDonalds soaking up the air conditioning. What? I am from Wisconsin! What do I know of heat? Before we took off we treated ourselves to an ice cream cone while Lee cooled down. I am happy to say we made the edge of town with no more problems.

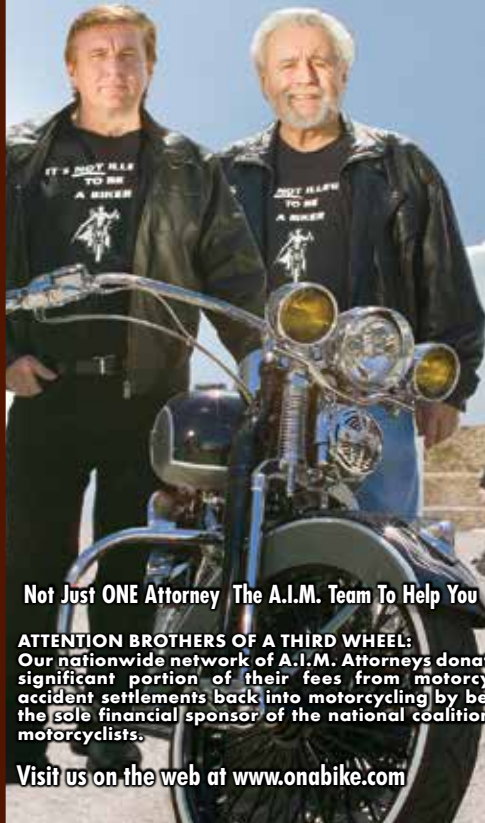

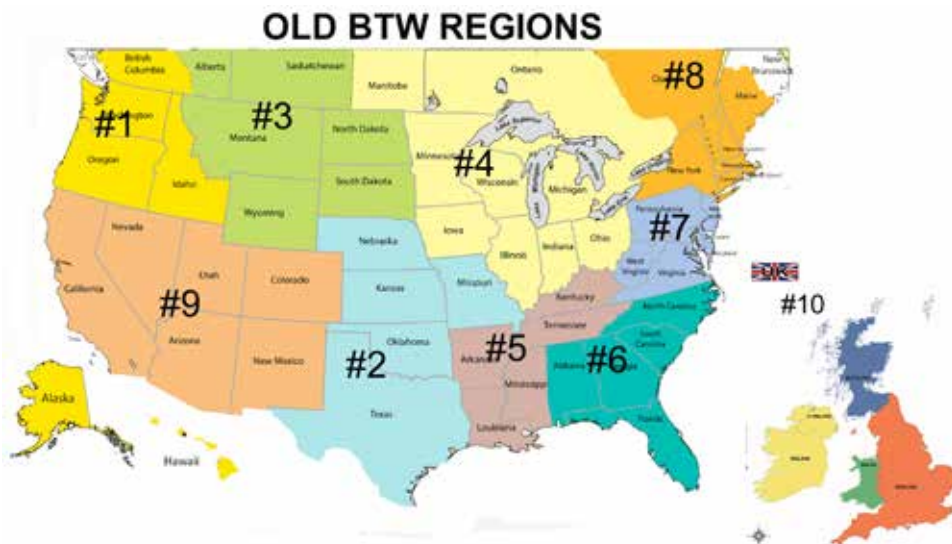

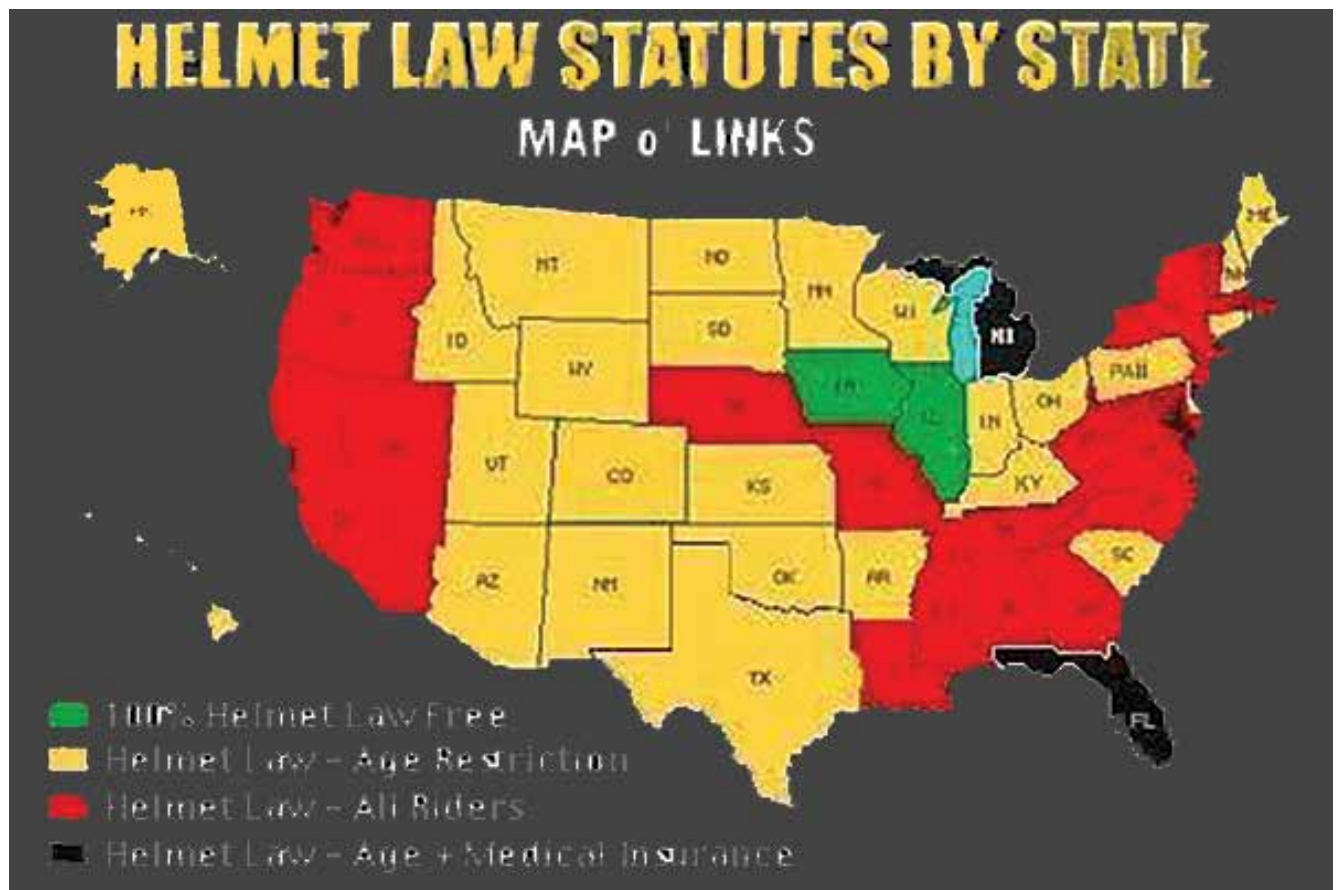

## MOTORCYCLE HAND SIGNALS



**Left turn**  
Arm and hand extending left, palm facing down



**Right turn**  
Arm out, bent at 90° angle, fist clenched.



**Stop**  
Arm extended straight down, palm facing back.



**Speed Up**  
Arm extended straight out, palm facing up, swing upward.



**Slow Down**  
Arm extended straight out, palm facing down, swing down to your side.



**Follow Me**  
Arm extended straight up from shoulder, palm forward.



**You Lead/Come**  
Arm extended upward 45°, palm forward pointing with index finger, swing in arc from back to front.



**Hazard in Roadway**  
On the left, point with left hand; on the right, point with right foot.



**Single File**  
Arm and index finger extended straight up.



**Double File**  
Arm with index and middle finger extended straight up.



**Comfort Stop**  
Forearm extended, fist clenched with short up and down motion.



**Refreshment Stop**  
Fingers closed, thumb to mouth.



**Turn Signal On**  
Open and close hand with fingers and thumb extended.



**Pull Off**  
Arm positioned as for right turn, forearm swung toward shoulder.



**Cops Ahead**  
Tap on top of helmet with open palm down.



**Fuel**  
Arm out to side pointing to tank with finger extended.
