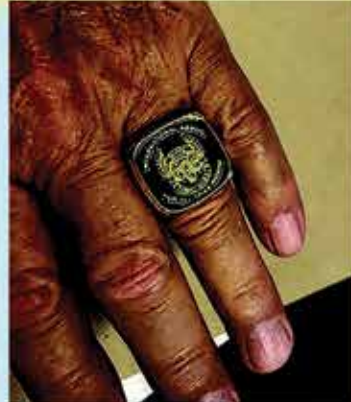

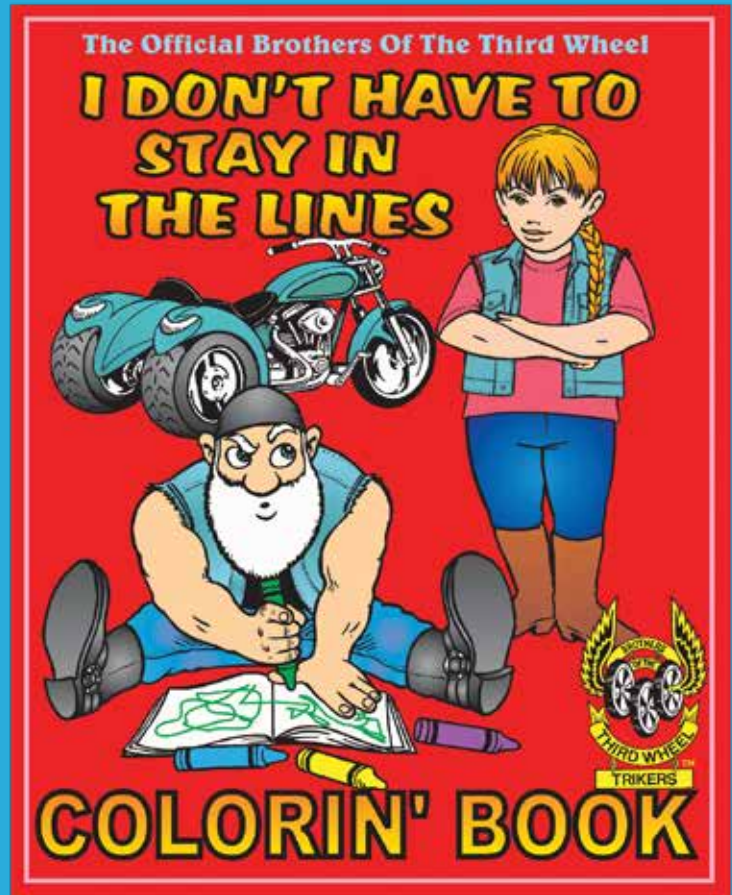

FROM THE INDUSTRY

Leaning Three Wheels

The Piaggio line of MP3 Scooters have been leaning through curves with three wheels since 2006. It was pretty cool technology and I test rode the largest 500cc model. I found the performance lacking and the CVT transmission uninspiring, but liked the unique leaning scooter trike.

In 2018 Yamaha introduced a full sized Multi Wheeled Leaning Machine with an 853cc triple engine borrowed from their MT09 that made over 100 HP. The Niken allows a lean angle of 45 degrees with the front 15-inch wheels spaced 16 inches apart and handles like a regular motorcycle. Most non-sport bikes can't achieve that. The front suspension uses parallel quadrilateral arms mounted outboard of the wheels to allow maximum lean and comprises two fork legs per side including a rear leg with adjustable pre-load and damping, and a front leg for alignment. Ackerman steering geom-



etry is handled by a separate group of tie rods and linkages, including offset steering knuckles. The sophisticated engineering allows each wheel to work independently over bumps for a smooth ride, but the system adds almost 100 pounds over the MT09 Tracer.

Unlike the MP3, it does not lock upright at a stop.

In 2019 Yamaha introduced the Niken GT touring machine and I bought one last year. Outside of an annoying vibration at 70 MPH, it is smooth, powerful, comfortable and confidence inspiring. Two contact patches upfront provide better traction and braking than a two-wheeled motorcycle, especially in less-than-ideal road conditions. I've ridden it on long-distance over-

nights and carved corners on mountain roads with equal aplomb. It seems to attract attention wherever I go, even when riding with Iceman on the Venom!

Some friends have taken it for a spin and enjoyed it, always amazed that it feels like a regular motorcycle.

Recently, a Snowbird buddy of mine, Ron, took it for a spin over a couple of mountain passes in the Tucson area. He and his wife Chris come down to Arizona from Green Bay every winter for a week or so. She rides too and took my Royal Enfield 650 for the scenic loop with a couple of other friends. Ron loved it and said he forgot there were two wheels up front, as you can't see them from the saddle.

When my brother-in-law visit from Ohio last year, he said it was his favorite "bike" of all he rode. One of the things I love about BTW is the diversity of trike designs and styles. I'm happy to contribute to that diversity, even though beauty is often in the eye of the beholder.

THE TUCSON-MT. LEMMON RIDE



Ride start base of Mt. 2,000 ft.

This ride is very unique, as it is very close to downtown Tucson yet allows you the luxury of experiencing the total gammit of terrain from the desert floor to the pine forest at 8,000 ft. above sea level. The ride starts at the foot of Mt Lemmon which is right in the north east suburb of town and begins to climb immediately at a nice slow rise through the cactus laden hills which quickly changes to the more rocky brush land at the 4,000 ft. mark.



at 3,000 ft.

You then can stop at the many rest areas and lookouts. As you climb through the winding road where you experience views of most of the southern part of Arizona from way up.



at 4,000 ft

As you get to 5,000 ft. level the entire terrain changes to a northern pine forest with lots of natures treasures, You can stop at the lake on the way up or down, there are many camp sites at diferent levels and to top it off when you get to the 8,000 ft. mark, you have restaurants, fudge shops, pizza parlor, and several other attractions. Now if that is not enough, you can jump back on the trike and go the last 1,000 ft. to the ski resort with dining room,



at 5,000 ft.

and don't forget the chair lift ride, then on to the observatory at 9,157 ft.

This entire ride only goes about 8-10 miles from the city as the crow flies, but you have traveled 25 miles of winding glorious scenery all the way to the top.

The weather for this ride allows you to pick your temperatures. We made the run in late April and the temp in Tucson was a beautiful dry 88 degrees. and as we climbed it gradually dropped to a final temp of 65 degrees. So the tank tops got covered with the vest or sweater about half way up and off half way down.

This may sound like a very short ride but I guarantee you, it is a full days adventure with a feeling of total satisfaction once you ascend back

to the desert floor and the busy streets of Tucson.

When the desert floor gets to be 110 degree in midsummer, this is the fastest escape to a comfortable 75 degree oasis for ice cream mid day and return as the sun sets and the temperature drops uder a 100 on the desert floor.

For those who might wish to make it an extended trip, as I mentioned prior, there are many good campsites at different elevations and a resort with casitas, and cabins for rent.



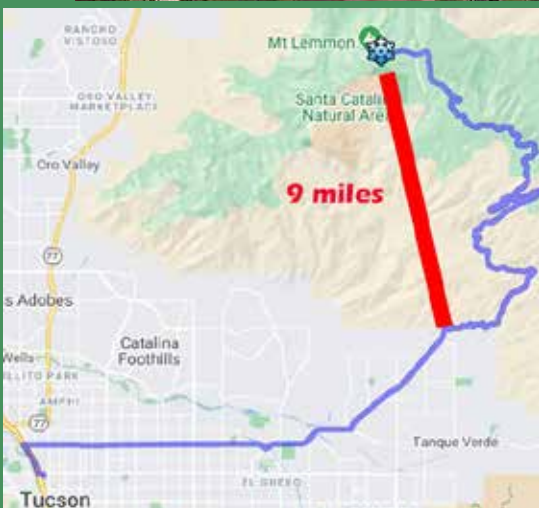
Don't forget to gas up at the bottom of the moutain as there are no service stations up there.

From a personal point of view, you can make this ride over and over again and see something new every time, such as bears deer, mountain goats, javalina, bob cats, mt. lions and my favorite "Geckos". The road is very good, and lots of places to

stop, rest, photos, picnics, pee and in all my travels I have not found another ride so close to town and yet so diverse.

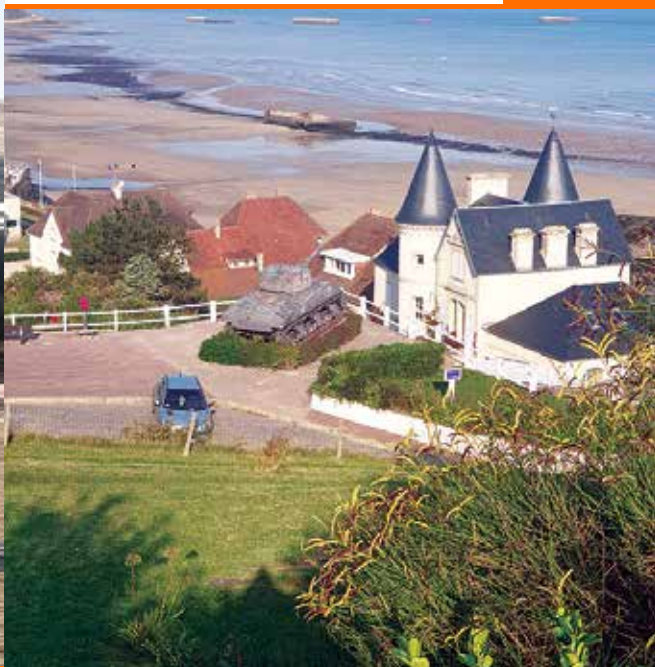

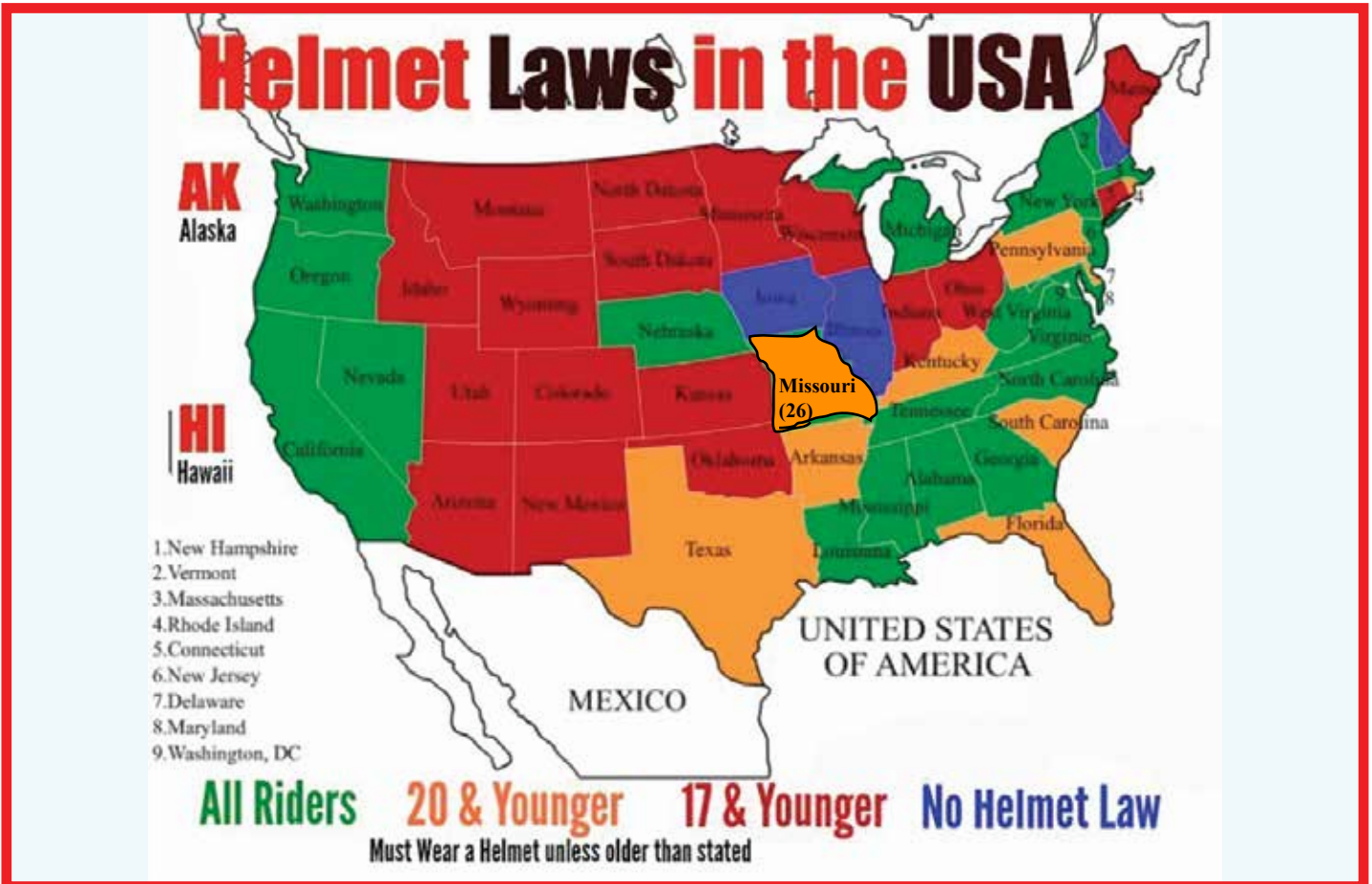

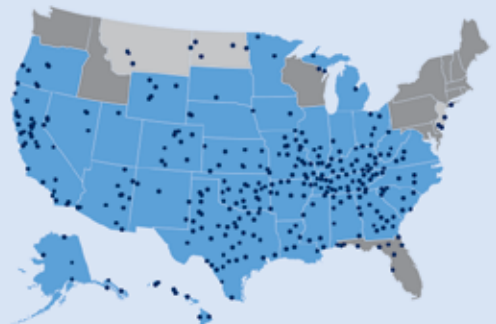

BTW BOD Elections

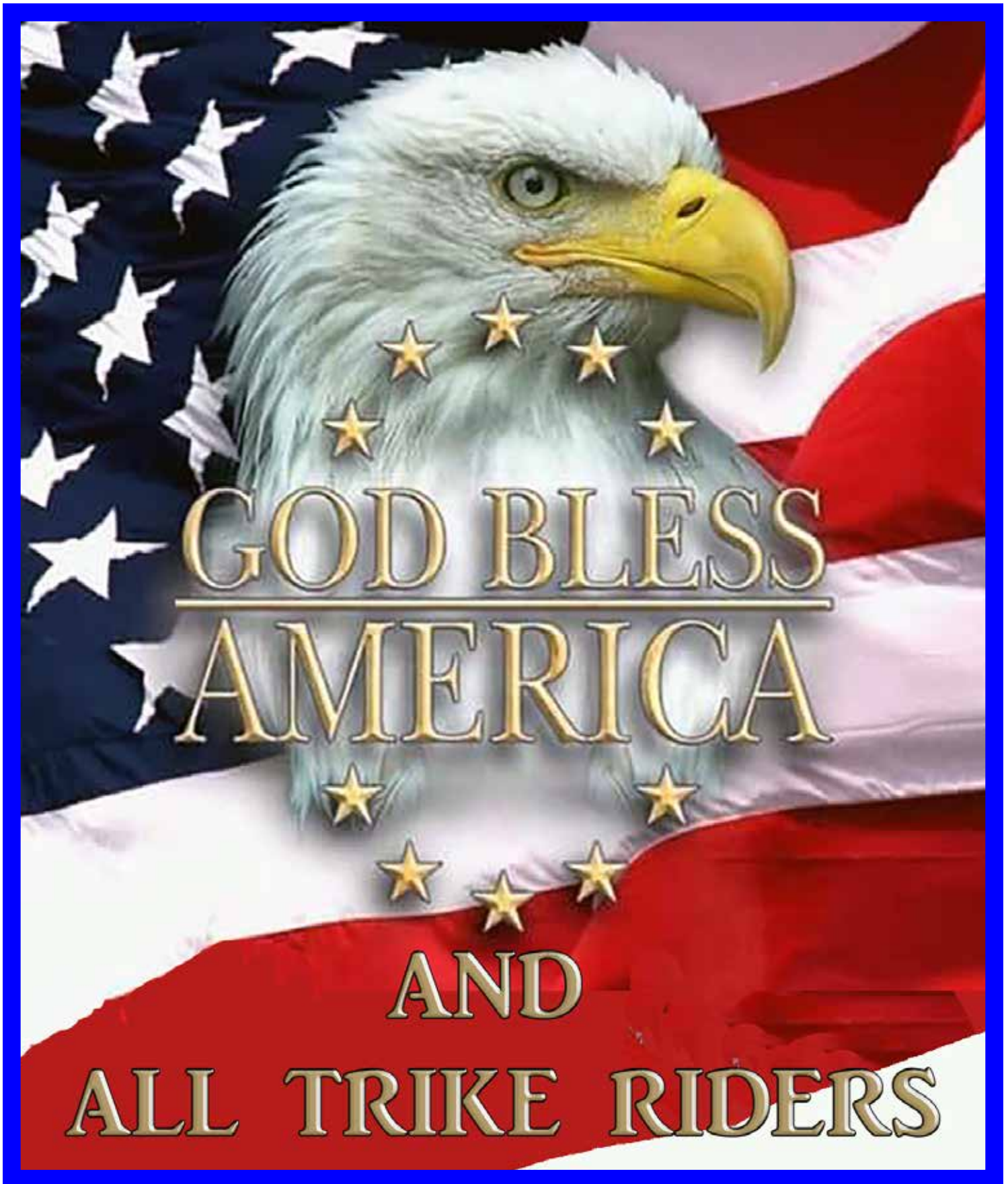
If it is your Region's turn to vote for your Director, have your Chapter or State Director contact HQ and get the documentation for the election.
