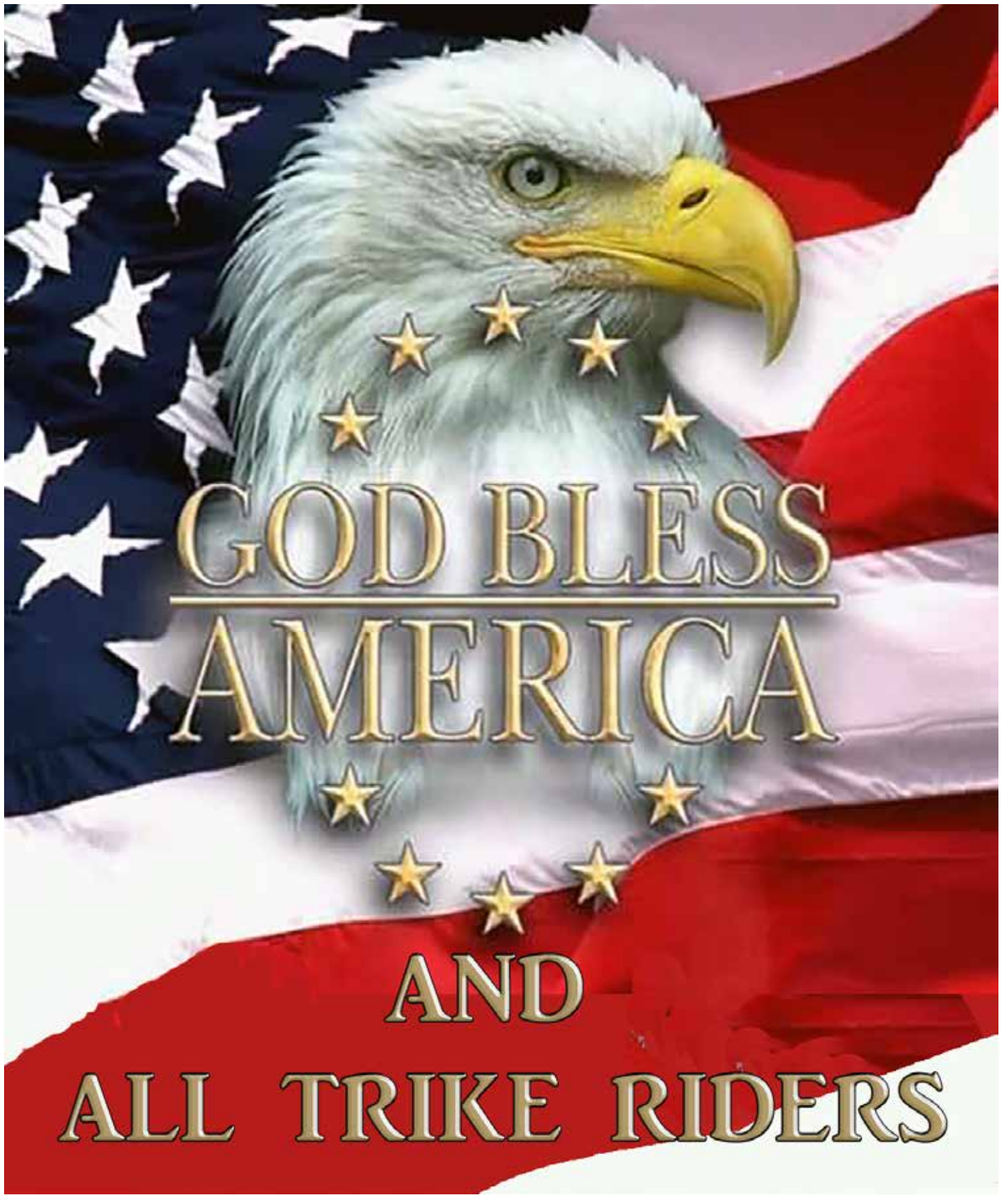

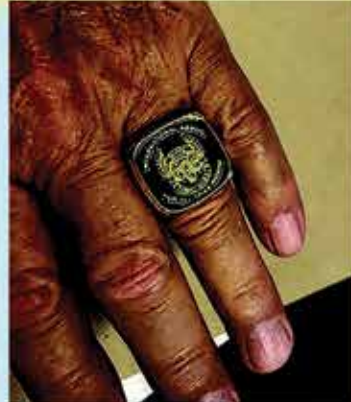

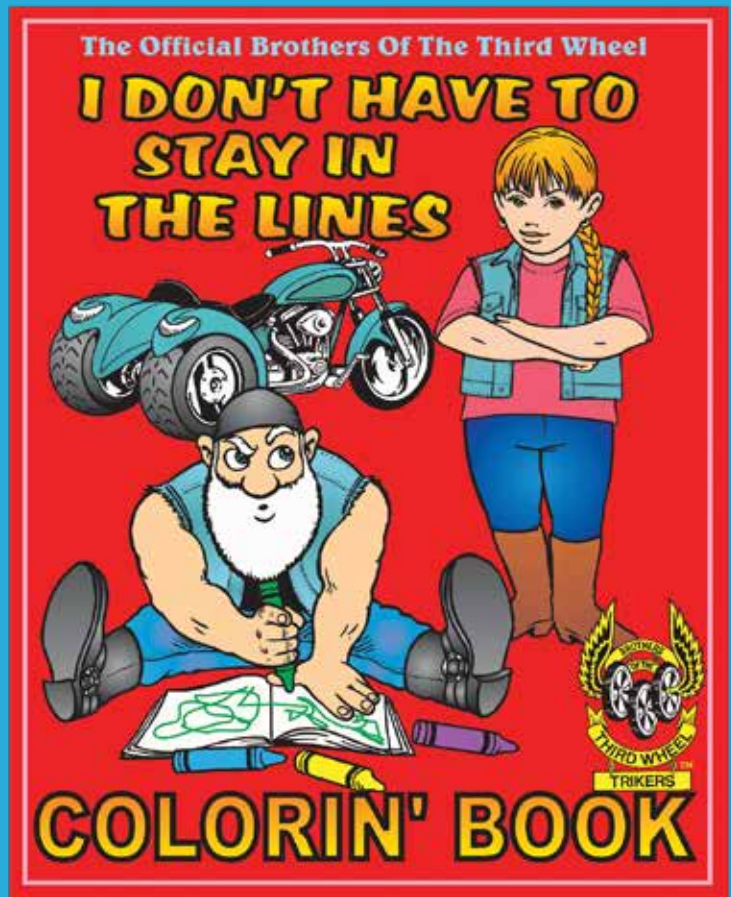

Snowbirds flock to sunny Arizona in the winter and Ron and Chris Terrien are no exception. They come down from frigid Green Bay, WI every year to ride roads that aren't covered in ice and snow and this year they drove their RV down for a month. His favorite turned out to be the Yamaha Niken GT with two wheels up front that will lean up to 45 degrees in turns.

To truly enjoy a trike that leans in turns, there are few roads better than the Catalina Highway, that snakes its way up 27 miles of two-lane to Mt. Lemmon.

It handles like a regular motorcycle, but with the added confidence of a second contact patch up front for when traction becomes challenging. Most riders, soon forget that there is a second wheel up there soon after riding off.



There was no ice on the road, but there was snow on the side of the road and on the slopes of Ski Valley, at the 9,000-foot top. We thought Ron might be getting homesick for Green Bay so we rode to the top and then had lunch outside on the deck of the Sawmill Run Restaurant in Summerhaven, AZ. 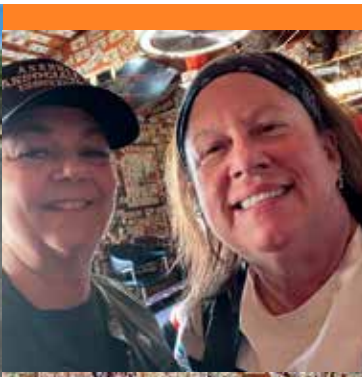

IF YOU TAKE PHOTOS WITH YOUR PHONE AND IT IS SET AT 72 PIXELS IT IS THE LOWEST QUALITY OF PICTURE THAT THE PHONE PRODUCES. MOST PHONES CAN BE SET TO A GREATER PIXEL OUTPUT.

EACH PHONE SETTING IS DIFFERENT, HOWEVER YOUR SERVICE PROVIDER CAN HELP WITH HOW THAT IS DONE. A SETTING OF 150 PIXELS IS GOOD AND 200 PIXELS WILL GIVE YOU A BEAUTIFUL PHOTO, THAT WILL NOT BE GRAINY AND THE COLORS WILL BE TRUE AND SHARP. PHOTOS THAT WE RECEIVE AT HQ IN 72 PIXELS ARE RUN THROUGH A PROGRAM TO CLEAN THEM UP BUT NOT MUCH HAPPENS AS THE BASE IS SO LOW THAT THE PROGRAM CAN ONLY LIGHTEN OR DARKEN THEM. THIS IS JUST A TIP SO WE CAN POST BETTER PICTURES IN THE MAGAZINE TO MAKE YOUR TRIKE LOOK ITS BEST AND OF COURSE YOU AS WELL. HOWEVER IN MY CASE IT WOULD TAKE MORE THAN MORE PIXELS TO MAKE ME LOOK GOOD

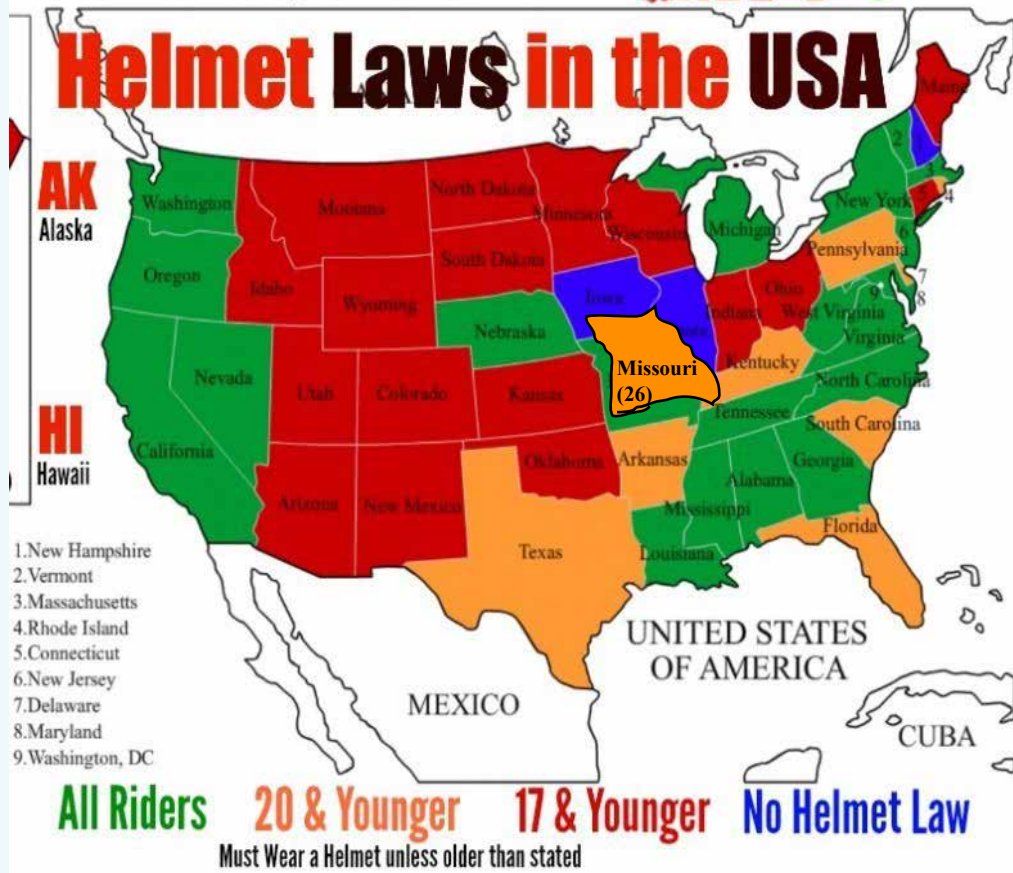

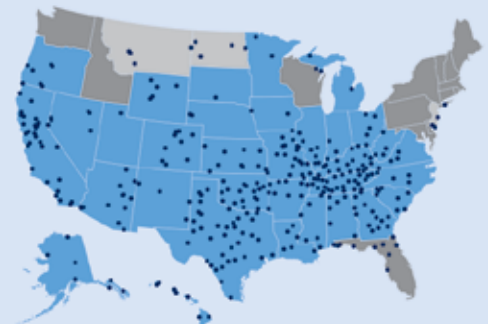

## **BTW BOD Elections**

BTW is split into 10 Regions; 9 of these regions are in the USA and Canada and the final one covers all areas outside of the USA & Canada. Each Region has a Regional Director.
