So Bad But Soooo Good

I would like to share an experience with you that happened to me at the Pacific Northwest Regional Trike-in located at Packwood, WA.

I almost didn't go because of back issues that keep me slightly bent over and unable to walk very far. My trike was running like a raped ape without a halter, my tent trailer was in excellent shape, towing straight and true, so why not.

Saturday morning I hoped on the trike and it turned over, and over, and over, nothing. After breakfast the guys from Bridge City Trikers came over to look at my trike (Paco, Jeff, Larry, Marvin). We decided that it must be either the coil or the distributor. Now what, I am a long ride from parts and tools. We found a universal coil in the next little town, brought it back and installed it. Nothing. It was determined that it was the module in the electronic ignition most likely the culprit. My neighbor broke the lock off my garage and pulled the distributor and coil off another engine and put it on the front porch. Now the dreaded phone call to my sister. "Hello sister would you do me a favor and pick up some parts and drive them up to Packwood?" While on the phone 3 or 4 people gathered around and asked if I could use some help. Dave Hancock comes over and started talking about this guy with a red Rewaco trike that had washed and hand buffed it too many times I had to ask if the paint was coming off. He walked over and saw my tools on the ground and asked "what's the matter?" I tell him the story and that I have the electronics headed my way. He introduced himself as Russ Lamb and I gave him mine, we walked over to the Rewaco to look.

Russ asked me if I was sure that the electronics are the problem. I told him I was as sure as I can be. Russ tells me that there are ways to check the electronics to be sure. It was determined that the module was in fact bad. Russ offers to put the old points and condenser in the distributor and get me running again. I tell him the parts are on the way. My sister arrived with the parts and almost as if on cue, Russ came over with his endless supply of parts and tools and a crimp on a couple of wires and the parts are in. I turn the key and again it won't start. With everyone standing around helping we managed to overlook the fact that we needed to put the rotor back in. After a good laugh and a rotor install my trike fired right up and was running great. Had a good visit with my sister, some of the members talked with her and made her feel welcome. Won a few things at the raffle and then off to bed.

We decided to leave early Sunday morning, so I am up at first light packing the trailer and getting ready for the ride home. Paco rode up and helped me hook up the trailer and do a light check, all is well and we are off. We pulled into Randal for breakfast and off we went again. Morton was 5 miles away, almost to the top of the pass and Pow, Pow, Pow, bang, bang, snap. Wondering what's wrong now, I coasted over the pass and found a wide spot to pull off the road. Jeff checked and found that number 4 cylinder was cold.

Continued: We pulled the plug and it was fouled. Cleaned the plug, started the engine and the bad noises returned. Now what??? Marvin, one of the guys from the trike-in, pulls up and asked “Now What?” After some checking Jeff said that the elephant foot adjuster broke and the push rod fell down into the engine. The local parts store said that they could get the part I needed but it would not be there until Tuesday. I was thinking I would have my nephew pull more parts out of storage and get comfortable on the side of the road for 3-4 hours waiting. Marvin said “my trike is on the trailer and we could take the lifter assembly off of his engine to get mine going again and he would get his engine back together after he got home”. I was surprised as Marvin has a very pristine Nova trike. Marvin was planning on doing a valve job and changing the air manifolds. Continued To make a long story short we ended up using the whole rocker assembly from Marvin’s trike. We got the engine buttoned up and turned the key, she fired right up and ready to go. Then Russ Lamb pulls up and asks if we need any help. Told him that it was a long story but I was back together and headed home.

I would like to thank everyone that was involved in helping me. What a trip! Well there is a point to this story. Even when things went downhill, trike people, not just Bridge City Triker’s but trike people I didn’t know, Russ, the gal with the same birthday, Couple from Mt Shasta and everyone that just stopped to talk. To me this makes a great club. People coming together wanting to take a few extra steps for someone else. I have ridden with a couple of other groups in the old days of 2 wheels and there was not that kind of camaraderie. Weeks later writing this I am still in awe over the people wanting to help.

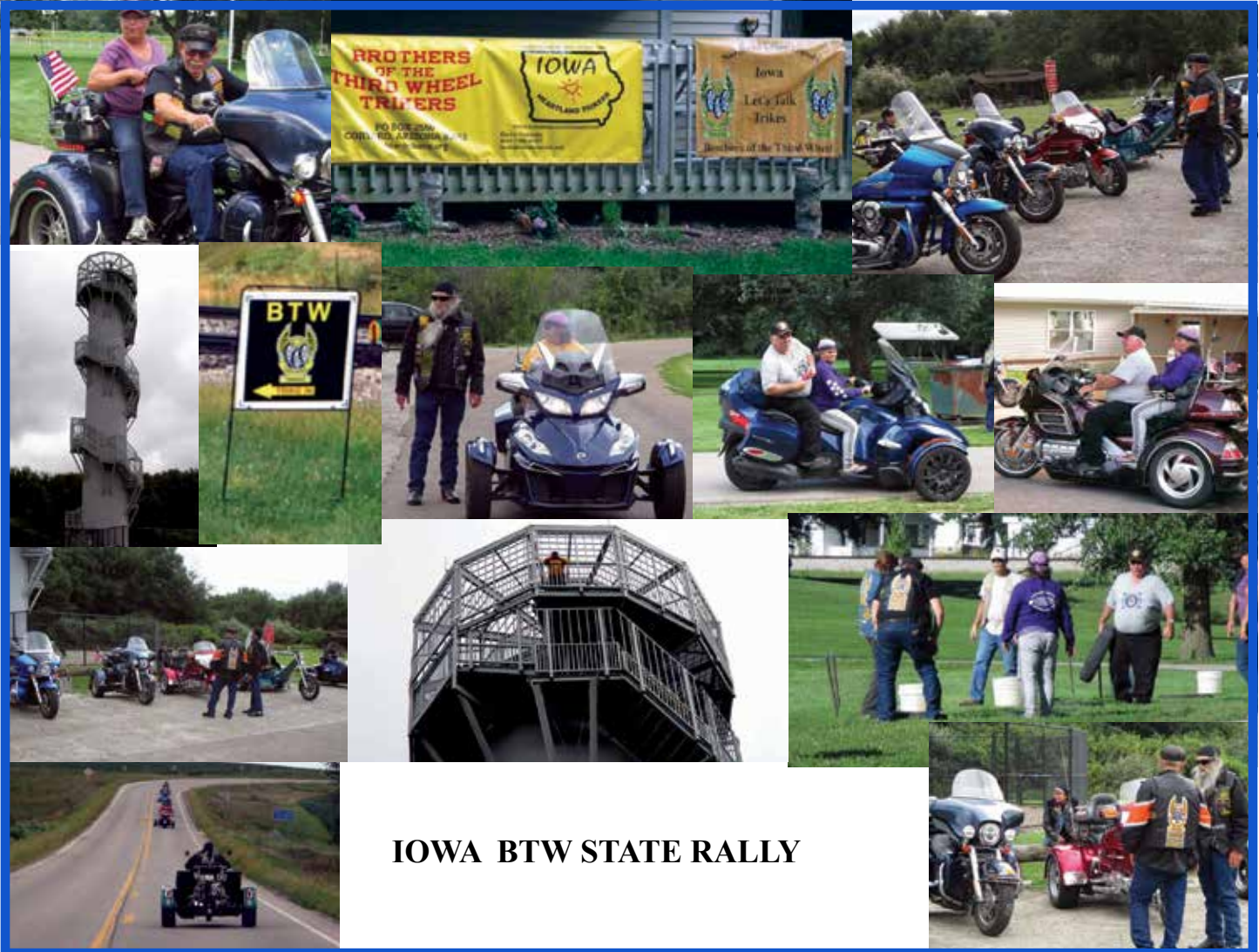

BTW BOD Elections
