# FROM THE WEB

## 5 ITEMS TO CHECK BEFORE YOU RIDE THAT COULD MAKE YOUR RIDE MORE ENJOYABLE



**1: Tires, check your tires to make sure they are properly inflated. Every rider should know the proper PSI rating for their tires. Checking them when they are cold is best. Check them for any wear, anything embedded, broken or damaged spokes and rims, and make sure the tread is adequate.**

**2: Lights, Make sure all lights are in good working order. Head lights (High and Low Beam), Brake lights and Turn Signals. Check that the covers are not loose or cracked, are free of dirt and bugs, and that the bulbs are bright enough to be seen. (Always carry extra fuses.)**

**3: Controls. Make sure your cables are in good condition, not worn or frayed, no kinks or bends, and are securely connected. Check your clutch and brake levers, make sure they are not loose, that they pull easily and return to their proper position. Look at your brake and shifter, make sure they are attached securely, not bent, and in proper working order. Double Check Your Brakes.**

**4: Fluids. Check your fluids, make sure your oil level is sufficient. Improper oil level could damage your bike. Everyone should know their bikes correct oil weight, and how to check and fill it properly. Check your gas, you may have used more or forgotten to fill up after your last ride. Your boots are not made for walking.**

**5. Know your hand signals if required & if your riding in another state make sure you know the helmet laws.**

## **Michigan Reclassifies License Requirements for Autocycles Three-wheel vehicles gain traction in 38 states**

Good news for open-air autocycle fans—Michigan is the latest state to reclassify its operator licensing requirements for freaky, three-wheeled vehicles like the Polaris Slingshot. Drivers no longer need a motorcycle license to operate one, but most bikers will still make fun of you when you they roll up on you. Newbies in states like Michigan can ride autocycles with a valid state driver's license, though getting a motorcycle endorsement wouldn't hurt, and it would most likely increase your chances of survival out on the road.

Michigan law defines an autocycle as “an enclosed motorcycle that is equipped with safety belts, rollbar, windshield wipers, steering wheel, and equipment otherwise required on a motorcycle, and which has not more than three wheels in contact with the roadway at any one time.”

Laws still vary from state to state, but at least 31 require an autocycle to have three wheels and 27 require a steering wheel. Three-wheeled trikes like the Harley-Davidson Tri Glide Ultra still require a motorcycle license and are equally silly looking.

The Slingshot made its debut in 2014 and most consumers were required to hold a motorcycle endorsement or license to operate it. These days it is not required in a number of states.

“We are proactively educating states about the innovation Slingshot delivers to consumers. As we do this, policymakers recognize that although Slingshot resides in the motorcycle classification which has long provided for three-wheel designs and non-straddle seating, operator skills are similar to those required for passenger car,” said Rachael Elia, Slingshot marketing manager, in a statement.

“Our goal is to gain a unified classification and operator licensing scheme across the country to provide more opportunities and driving freedom for consumers looking for the ultimate thrill experience that Slingshot offers.”

The new law in Michigan went into effect on October 11.

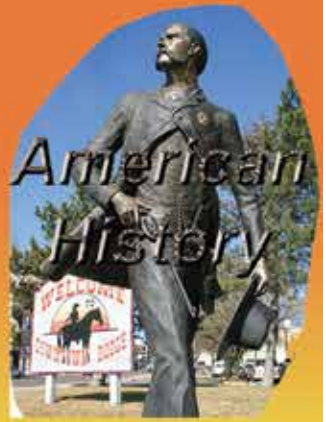

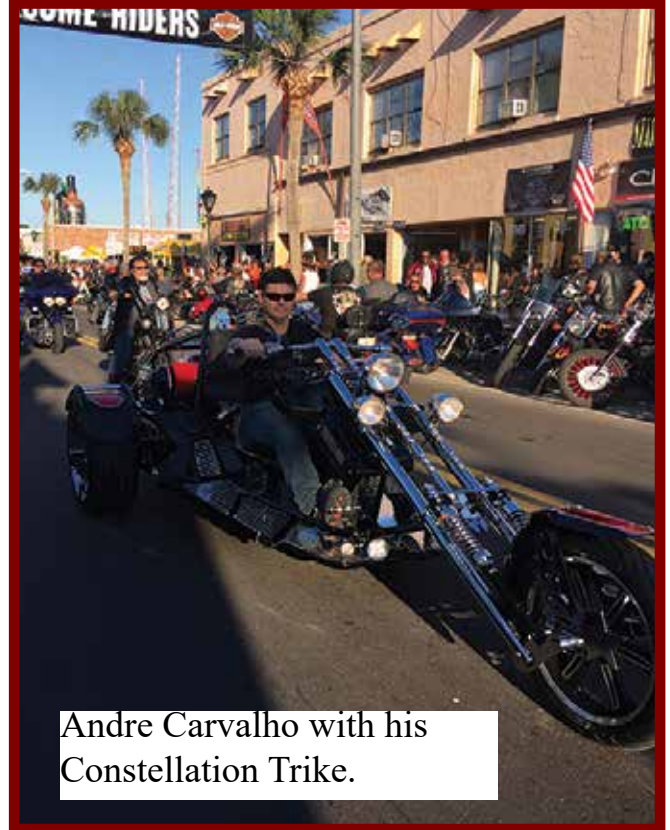

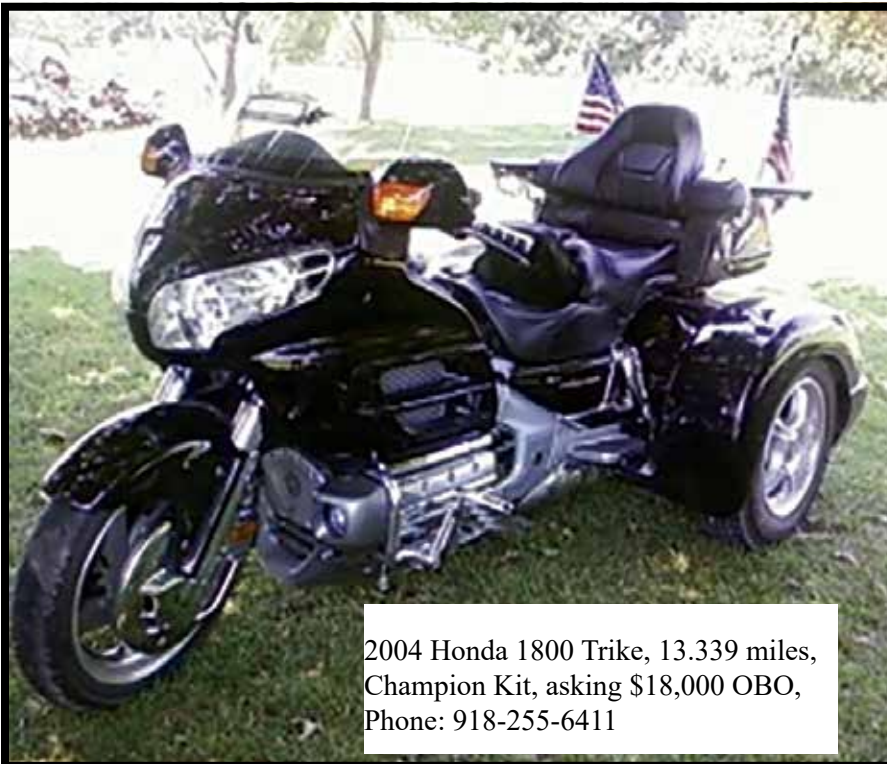

### AMCN Membership Terms and Conditions

AirMedCare Network is an alliance of affiliated air ambulance providers\* (each a "Company"). An AirMedCare Network membership automatically enrolls you as a member in each Company's membership program. Membership ensures the patient will have no out-of-pocket flight expenses if flown by a Company by providing prepaid protection against a Company's air ambulance costs that are not covered by a member's insurance or other benefits or third party responsibility, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Patient transport will be to the closest appropriate medical facility for medical conditions that are deemed by AMCN Provider attending medical professionals to be life- or limb-threatening, or that could lead to permanent disability, and which require emergency air ambulance transport. A patient's medical condition, not membership status, will dictate whether or not air transportation is appropriate and required. Under all circumstances, an AMCN Provider retains the sole right and responsibility to determine whether or not a patient is flown.
2. AMCN Provider air ambulance services may not be available when requested due to factors beyond its control, such as use of the appropriate aircraft by another patient or other circumstances governed by operational requirements or restrictions including, but not limited to, equipment manufacturer limitations,

governmental regulations, maintenance requirements, patient condition, age or size, or weather conditions. FAA restrictions prohibit most AMCN Provider aircraft from flying in inclement weather conditions. The primary determinant of whether to accept a flight is always the safety of the patient and medical flight crews. Emergent ground ambulance transport of a member by an AMCN Provider will be covered under the same terms and conditions.

3. Members who have insurance or other benefits, or third party responsibility claims, that cover the cost of ambulance services are financially liable for the cost of AMCN Provider services up to the limit of any such available coverage. In return for payment of the membership fee, the AMCN Provider will consider its air ambulance costs that are not covered by any insurance, benefits or third party responsibility available to the member to have been fully prepaid. The AMCN Provider reserves the right to bill directly any appropriate insurance, benefits provider or third party for services rendered, and members authorize their insurers, benefits providers and responsible third parties to pay any covered amounts directly to the AMCN Provider. Members agree to remit to the AMCN Provider any payment received from insurance or benefit providers or any third party for air medical services provided by the AMCN Provider, not to exceed regular charges. Neither the Company nor AirMedCare

Network is an insurance company. Membership is not an insurance policy and cannot be considered as a secondary insurance coverage or a supplement to any insurance coverage. Neither the Company nor AirMedCare Network will be responsible for payment for services provided by another ambulance service.

4. Membership starts 15 days after the Company receives a complete application with full payment; however, the waiting period will be waived for unforeseen events occurring during such time. Members must be natural persons. Memberships are non-refundable and non-transferable.
5. Some state laws prohibit Medicaid beneficiaries from being offered membership or being accepted into membership programs. By applying, members certify to the Company that they are not Medicaid beneficiaries.

I simply love the Holidays and all that goes with them. Turkey and all the fixin’s for Thanksgiving and Ham and all the trimmings for Christmas. The smell throughout the house of Holly and other greenery is memorizing and all the family coming home is a thrill. Nothing and I mean nothing, makes me happier than Holidays in the Fall. Others are given out as gifts to neighbors, friends, family and gift exchanges. Then others are frozen, to be eaten only at Christmas. The cookies are still not sampled by any close member of the family. Tasting any of the product is Voodoo, cause for instant inheritance, death or dismemberment.

Finally Christmas Day arrives and everyone brings homemade candy, cakes, pies and other goodies to eat and the cookies are sadly forgotten. Throughout the Holiday Season we feast on leftovers, other people's desserts and sweets that were left for us, we allow our sacred "*Christmas Cookies*" to frost up and crumble apart in our freezer like they were second class morsels. When we do take them out of the freezer, they usually go to the birds to sustain them through the rest of the Spring and make room for the Easter leftovers.
