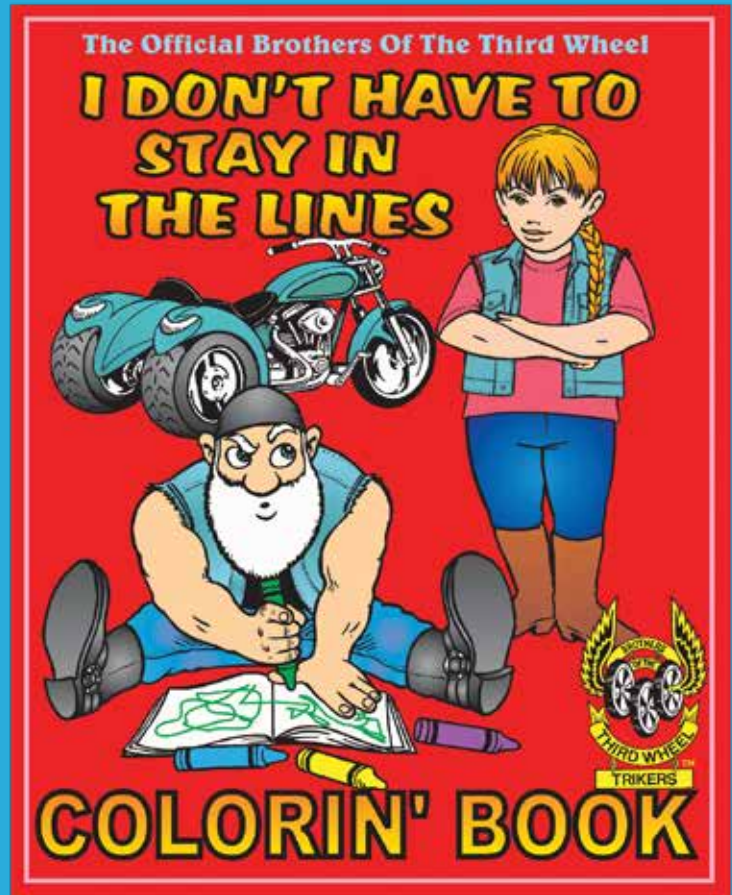

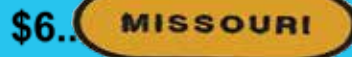



Please take care, stay safe, and enjoy the wind in your face. Cat Schoubroeck, Region 5 Director

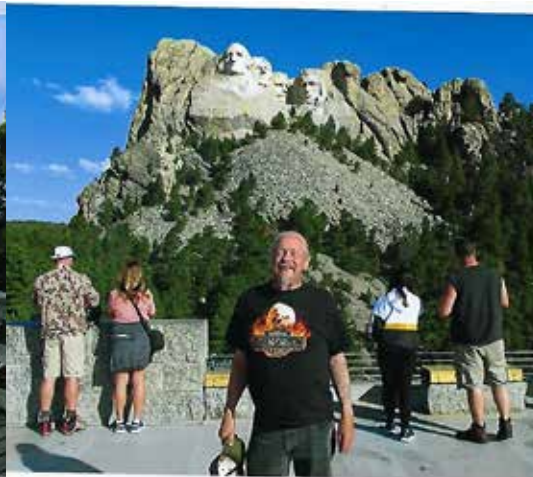

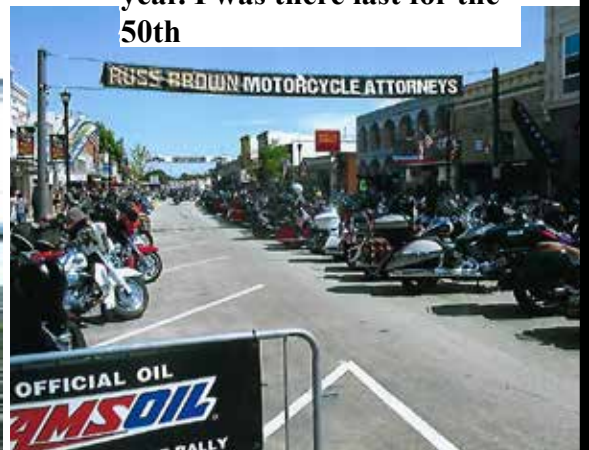
