FROM THE MEMBERS

Sturgis at 74

A little over ten years ago my wife and I lived just outside Jacksonville, Florida. The last year I was there I bought a Harley and since I was only about an hour away, I went to Bike Week and Octoberfest in Daytona. That gave me the desire to go to the mother of all rallies, Sturgis.

Two years ago, I decided to do it but on the way I got food poisoning and had to return home. Last year was Covid and since there was no vaccine, I didn't want to chance it.

This year, since I was fully vaccinated, I decided I would check it off my bucket list but I had several concerns. First, I am 74 years old and although I'm in good shape, 74 is old. (There, I admitted it to the world. I'm an old man.) Secondly, I knew that over 95% of the motorcycles there would be Harleys. Not only do I not ride a Harley, but I ride a Polaris Slingshot. For those of you that don't know what they are, they look more like a car than a motorcycle. When young children ask me what it is I tell them it's my Batmobile. Technically they are a 3 wheeled motorcycle but since they have a steering wheel and you sit side by side next to your passenger I wasn't sure if it would be accepted by the Harley crowd.

I will digress for a minute and explain my concern. While I was there, I was sitting on a bench talking to a guy who lived about 100 miles away and has been going to Sturgis for close to 40 years. He told me that in the old days if someone parked a Honda or any other non-Harley motorcycle on Main Street, someone would tie a rope to it and drag it off Main Street and leave what was left of it in a ditch somewhere.

Now, back to my story. Since I was excited about going, I planned my trip months in advance. Since I live in NW Washington I planned to drive across the state of Montana. For people not familiar with Montana it's a very big state. Well, about a week before I was scheduled to leave I realized that all the wildfires out west filled Montana with dangerous levels of smoke.

So, I canceled all my reservations except for my stay in Rapid City about 30 minutes from Sturgis. My new route took me through Boise, Idaho. It added about 400 miles on to my trip but was far enough south to avoid the unhealthy smoke. I left a day early because of the extra distance but before I left, I looked and found out the smoke had cleared out enough that I could have gone as originally planned but I didn't want to change everything again.

The weather for my days on the road started from cool to cold and ended from hot to hotter than blazes. One day when I left St. Anthony, Idaho it was 50 degrees. When I got to Billings, Montana that afternoon it was 105 degrees. (The SS has a thermometer and I talked to a guy on a Harley and we both had 105 degree readings.)

A bit of advice, out West, rest areas and gas stations are a long way apart. Don't pass one up because it's crowded thinking that on the interstate there are plenty of places to refuel or get food. I did and when I finally got to one I had less than a gallon of gas left. That was the day it hit 105 and I had a cooling vest with me but didn't have any water to soak it with. I literally begged a gallon of water from a really, nice couple in an RV because the gas station I stopped at was closed and their water spigot was dry. I don't think I would have been able to continue without it.

After riding 1,650 miles, I arrived in Rapid City, South Dakota about 30 minutes away from Sturgis. I stayed in Rapid City because the hotels and motels in Sturgis were extremely expensive and they were pretty much booked by the time I decided to go. Expensive is over \$300 a night for a room at a motel

like Motel 6. If you want one, they are probably already booked for next year.

Here is what I found in Sturgis and the surrounding area. Everyone I met was super friendly and didn't care if you were on a Harley, a moped, or if your 3 wheeler had handlebars or a steering wheel. It was probably one of the friendliest, accepting groups of people I have ever experienced. (The attendance was estimated at over 500,000 this year.)

Actually, I had several 2 wheeled Harley riders showing a lot of interest in my Slingshot. The Harley population is getting older and it can be difficult to hold up a 900 pound 2 wheeler.

I arrived in Rapid City on Monday and got up Tuesday morning and headed to Sturgis. On the way there, traffic on Interstate 90 slowed almost to a stop. The cause, a highway patrol cop was having a man, who was still straddling his Harley, blow into a breathalyzer on the shoulder of the interstate next to the high speed left lane. What really made it interesting is that it was only ten o'clock in the morning.

Finding a place to park was expensive. I pulled into a lot that said motorcycle parking \$5. When I pulled in the guy explained I couldn't park in the motorcycle lot because my Slingshot was too big but he had a couple of spots just outside the lot that I could park in for \$20. It was a bit steep but I wasn't surprised. One thing I know, motorcycle prices don't apply to Slingshots anywhere. My parking spot was only about a block away from Main Street so it was worth it to me. (Did I tell you I'm an old man?)

On Main Street, cars are prohibited. I don't know why because I was able to drive down it and my Slingshot is wider than most cars. I guess they just don't like cars. (In Leesburg, Florida, they have a rally called Bikefest. They also park motorcycles in the middle of the street like at Sturgis.) At Bikefest they had barricades set up on Main Street that you needed to fit through or you couldn't ride through. My SS never would have fit.

So now I'll try to describe it. The rally covered an area about 4 blocks long on Main Street. There were many other streets and areas involved too but I'm going to stick with Main Street. Picture motorcycles of every description and color backed into the curb on both sides of the street. And as I mentioned earlier, they were also lined up perpendicularly to the flow of traffic on the centerline of the street. My personal favorite was a very normal looking bike except for the 427 cubic inch 8 cylinder engine. There were a lot more "exotic" looking bikes and trikes but I liked that one the best.

Then there were the stores. Both sides of the street were lined with bars, t-shirt shops, restaurants, motorcycle accessory stores etc.

I'm sure you get the picture. Many of the stores have music blasting out of speakers so as you walk along you go from one loud song to the next.

I walked up and down both sides of Main Street looking at the motorcycles lining the street and a few times at women wearing nothing but paint from the waist up. (Once again, I'm an old man but I'm not dead) If you're interested, I'm sure you can find a lot of pictures online. There's even a bar/restaurant in Alzada, Montana that has a contest they call Topless Tuesday. The bar is about an hour north of Sturgis. (This really is a big rally.) I stopped and ate lunch there on the way to Rapid City but it was Monday, one day early.

PACIFIC NW TRIKE-IN

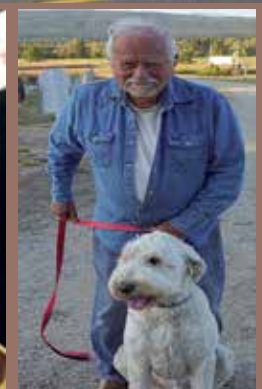
